# JULY 12, 2018 MEETING MINUTES - Tim Horn

Location: Fountain Hills School District Learning Center in Fountain Hills, AZ Call to Order at 7:02PM by Nancy Ordowski, Chair

- Prayer Tim Horn, LD23 1st Vice-Chairman
- Pledge of Allegiance
- Introductions of LD23 officers & elected officials in attendance Nancy: (State Reps. Jay Lawrence & Michele Ugenti-Rita, MCR Treasurer Sheila Muehling, MCR 2nd Vice-Chair Yvonne Cahill, FHUSD Governing Board Member Judy Rutkowski)
- Introductions of new PCs, LD23 officers, and guests Nancy
- Preview of next month's meeting: AZ Governor Candidate Forum at FHUSD Learning Center OR McDowell Mountain Ranch McDowell Center - Rich Rutkowski, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice Chair
- Announcements: USPS does not forward ballots. Temporary address change forms for ballots are available in the front of the room. Volunteers for Americans for Prosperity ballot initiative signature verification until July 18. Information on front table.
- Video Prager University: "America's Second War of Independence" was shown. The War of 1812 left Washington D.C. burned and New Orleans became the focal point where 12,000 British soldiers and 60 ships lost to Andrew Jackson and ended the war on 1/18/1815. 1700 British died in their attack and about a dozen American defenders were killed. A war hero, Jackson ultimately became President of the United States.
- U.S. Senate Candidate Forum: Rich Rutkowski, 2nd Vice-Chair
  - Joe Arpaio & Martha McSally were invited but declined. Arpaio had a scheduling conflict and McSally was in Washington, D.C. Dr. Kelli Ward was in attendance.
  - Summary of comments by Kelli Ward: Trump doing well, especially on North Korea foreign policy and veteran affairs; Left continues to attack & conservatives must push back; she had 19 bills passed while in AZ state senate; has an "America First Agenda" which includes "Build the Wall", then reform immigration; fully repeal Obamacare and allow a free-marketbased competitive system using HSAs (she mentioned her expertise in healthcare as a doctor and also a degree in Public Health); Cut spending and waste; defund Planned Parenthood; Increase military strength, but no nation building.
  - Q&A Session Ward was well received and many of the 40 or so attendees, including Ron Schott, Chris Brant, Dennis Weiland, & Sheila Muehling, offered good questions. Dr. Ward provided answers to the questions and explained her views on various issues.
- Additional candidate speakers
  - Kristina Kelly, an elementary school teacher in Scottsdale & new incoming LD23 PC, running in AZ State Senate seat primary against Ugenti-Rita and Jeffries, stresses her interest in education;

- Michelle Ugenti-Rita spoke stressing her 8-year history and current experience in AZ House, her Chairmanship of Ways and Means, and her ability to empower people.
- Jonathan Gelbart, candidate for State Superintendent of Public Education spoke about his West Valley upbringing, Stanford education, and his work with BASIS charter schools. He opposes tax increases and refers all to website 'ReplacetheModelT.com.'

  - Explained that restitution income is the result of a court order mandating payment from a former treasurer of the District.
- Tim Horn spoke about the success of the LD23 team in helping to stop the NPV Compact from being on the fall ballot in AZ ; and the team of Horn, Alex Melusky and Bob Hawthorne are planning to assist other states in their NPV battles as well; He also noted that he will be speaking about the NPV and his book "Ruling the Elite" (Amazon) on 90 radio station Saturday evening at 10pm on 1510 am; and encouraged PCs and others to set aside time and money now for assisting Republican candidates and issues in the fall campaign. Arthur Cooper made the point that LD23 PCs also worked successfully to stop the proposition to legalize recreational marijuana in Arizona.
