The 2016 Fly-in will be held June 11th at the Massey Aerodrome & Museum in Massey, MD. This change will take some adjustment, but our new host field is actually quite an improvement. The approaches are clear, the runway long & wide, the required set up for the fly-in is minimal and maybe with the change in date, the weather will be more favorable The dinner on Friday night before the fly-in will be held at the Kitty Knight House on the banks of the Sassafras River in Georgetown, MD. Please join your Squadron for our Holiday meeting and meal in the Hap Arnold building by the railroad tracks at College Park Airport. Please arrive around noon and bring a covered dish. I am sure there will be many questions and much discussion regarding our new fly-in location. Many of us attended the Massey holiday fly in in December to get a feeling for the flow of traffic and the lay of the land. We should also have someone from Massy joining us to help answer questions.

MINUTES OF THE MEETING POTOMAC ANTIQUE AERO SQUADRON

Sunday, October 25, 2015

President Art Kudner called the meeting to order at 1:43 in Peg Cannon's hangar at Kentmorr Airpark. He thanked Peg, and Sally and Evie, for their great hospitality, and thanked all who had brought food for our pot luck lunch.

We noted that one member had flown in: Lloyd Moroughan in his Luscombe, accompanied by Clark Cloukey. 16 members were present. This was the first meeting we have had since Horn Point in May 2015.

(Minutes continue...)

Our big, first question was: Where do we go from here? We have learned of big physical changes coming to the Horn Point Aerodrome in the next 1-2 years. and Stan Carlstadt visited Horn Point and learned: The University of Maryland is going to require the facility to generate some of their own power. Solar panels must be installed where we park airplanes, although the runways and the field's identity as an airport will remain. Almost certainly the field will remain as-is for 2016, but probably not for 2017.

We noted there had been a runway incident at Horn Point this year when a Great Lakes biplane veered into the trees, producing light damage to the aircraft, but no injury. (The third tree strike in 4 or 5 years – ed.). Everything else at Horn Point went well. There were 1 or 2 high profile antiques, including an early 1930s rare-model Waco open cockpit biplane. (Waco UBF – ed.)

Rich Van Iderstine gave a Treasurer's Report. Since the last report of March, 2015, we have received \$1057 in dues and Horn Point donations, and we have spent \$699.35, mostly on Horn Point and on the club's website -- this leaves a balance of \$5922.04. He said a lot of members need to pay dues. 40% of members are not paid up. That's 23 out of 57 who need to pay. Rich will contact the 23 about paying dues. I suggested that we give them one more positive contact. Mike Strieter asked: how many owe money longer than two years? Rich replied: five or six. There was additional discussion about non-payment by members. We will continue this at our next meeting, which we decided this will be in January.

There was much discussion about Massey Aerodrome, which, like Horn Point, is also on Maryland's Eastern Shore, in Massey, Md. They are a very probable alternative now that Horn Point will be radically altering their Aerodrome. Art provided a summary of restaurants and lodging. Tom Paradis suggested Cambridge Municipal Airport, and there was discussion about this paved commercial airport as an alternative. Will Alder asked, if we moved to Massey, would our fly-in still be called Horn Point? Art Kudner said that Massey Aerodrome has some new member/leaders and they are enthusiastic about having the Potomac Antique Aero Squadron use their facility.

We noted the conflict of May dates. Massey's Spring Chili Fly-In now takes place one week before Horn Point. I mentioned that for years, we have "taken" a very, very popular weekend for our fly-in.

Jerry Dicus suggested we &M have our fly-in at Horn Point one more year.

Lloyd Moroughan noted that Massey hosts other groups, including an antique glider fly-in, making a precedent for us to move there.

The discussion returned to that of Massey's schedule — and to how we would fit into it. Mike Strieter made the motion that for to our coming 2016 fly-in, we move to Massey Aerodrome, pending date selection and other factors to be decided, and that we assign a subcommittee to explore and decide this. The vote to do this was unanimous.

I asked about restaurants in the area for our Friday evening dinner and Art said there are two in Georgetown, Maryland, that would be suitable.

There was further discussion about whether we should do a work party at Massey to help prepare for our fly-in, and whether we should utilize and/or offer our supply of fly-in items, such as traffic cones, stakes, etc.

We resolved that we would have a January 2016 meeting at College Park Airport on January 17th, and that the subcommittee will report to the membership then.

Whereupon at 2:35, we took a break for our meal, with further discussion about fly-in locations to take place as we had lunch. The meeting reconvened at 3:21 PM -- with the consensus being that we will very likely move our fly-in to Massey Aerodrome this coming Spring.

I noted that we therefore bring a huge, pivotal movement for PAAS, as profound as when we were founded in 1968. We have conducted our annual fly-in at Horn Point Aerodrome every year since 1972, and the event has become a staple, of course, of aviation in the Mid-Atlantic area and for the antique airplane avocation in the United States. I noted that this works out to 44 years of the Horn Point, and that we could be proud and grateful that in this entire time, we had no serious injuries. The membership acknowledged this with light applause.

Whereupon, President Kudner adjourned the meeting at 3:24 PM.







FLY-IN PROCEDURES

- Landing aircraft will use a standard left-hand pattern, 1,000' MSL.
 Use appropriate runway based on wind directions. CTAF 122.9.
- 2. No touch and-go-landings.
- 3. Pilots MUST secure wing walkers before taxing into or out of aircraft parking area.
- 4. Absolutely no Fly-Bys across 02-20, or over the crowd or parking areas.
- 5. No aerobatics within a 5 mile radius of the field or near the town of Massey.

Road Directions from the South:

Route 301 north pass the route 50 exit. Continue on route 301 north. Turn right onto route 313, Galena Road. Galena Road turns into Maryland Line Road, route 330. Continue on Maryland Line road throug the town of Massey. Airfield will be on your right.
