REMARKS FROM OUR MYRTLE BEACH REUNION CHAIR

Greetings.

Covid may not be over, but we are back on schedule for your annual USS Macdonough reunion in May. This year's reunion will be held at The Beach Cove Resort, May 8-12. As it turns out the other Mac reunion group will be at the same hotel May 13-15. The Bayona's are planning to stay for both reunions to enjoy the beach and fellow shipmates.

Since Boom Boom handled the planning of this reunion, she had to shake things up a bit. Instead of the usual pizza dinner on Sunday, we will be having an AllAmerican cookout of hamburgers, hotdogs, and sides.

Some of you expressed an interest in a Dolphin Watch Cruise. I have arranged for a tour out of Crazy Sister Marina on Monday morning. The maximum number of guests is 40, so the first guests to register for the reunion and pay their fees will be guaranteed a seat. If you are not interested in the Dolphin tour, you can make your own arrangements to play golf, fish, shop, or enjoy the many pools at the resort.

Tuesday is a full day with a Memorial Service and box lunch aboard the Barefoot Queen. Later that day we will set sail for the Pirates Voyage dinner and theater.

Wednesday is a lazy day with only the Business meeting and a trivia game (with prizes) scheduled during the day and A Taste of Italy banquet in the evening.

All rooms at The Beach Cove resort are oceanfront suites. This includes a sitting room and kitchenette. As such, breakfast is not included in our room rate. If you would like to add a daily breakfast at the restaurant, please indicate that when you make your reservations. If you add breakfast for your entire stay, you will be charged an additional \$11.95 per person, per day. If you prefer, you can just drop by the restaurant and pay their regular rates. Our discounted room rate is \$117.60 per night, Sunday-Thursday. When making your reservation, please ask for the USS Macdonough DLG rate. The weekend rate, Friday-Sunday, is \$138.80 when you use the code is Beach Time Reunion. If you pay for your hotel before your arrival, or pay by DEBIT CARD, you will avoid the additional service fees for checking out with a credit card at the end of your stay.

Each of the outside activities require a final count by April 10. Therefore, registration forms and payment are due by April 1, 2022. We look forward to seeing you in Myrtle Beach.
