

Ashes

Please note: everyone may receive ashes. You are not required to be a practicing Catholic to receive ashes. Anyone and everyone is welcome to come forward to receive ashes.

Eucharistic Adoration

Between the morning and evening Masses of Ash Wednesday, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed in the Church. For the adoration, there is a sign-up sheet in the back of the church. Please sign up to take a half hour or hour of presence with our Lord in the Eucharist.

Fasting & Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.
