



A MESSAGE ABOUT REVITALIZATION OF BAY HILLS DEED RESTRICTIONS

The Deed Restriction Revitalization Committees are actively addressing the issues raised during the April homeowner meeting. Bay Hills HOA is involved to provide coordination and communication about the process, but is not, has never been, and has no intention to become the governing entity of the subdivision deed restrictions.

We are committed to resolving concerns related to extending variances permanently or, ideally, removing problematic restrictions entirely before proceeding with the revitalization process.

We are seeking available legal avenues to address these matters effectively and will share updates as soon as they become available.

While only a simple majority (50% + 1) is required to approve the revitalization of our deed restrictions, the goal is to develop a solution that gains widespread support among all homeowners.

Thank you for your patience and support as we work through these challenges.
