

Your Semi-Custom BBolder Touch-Up Kit will maintain your color on your part and hairline between appointments. This simple color formulation is *not* your exact custom color. It is only to be used on your part and around your hairline for aesthetic purposes, until your next hair appointment. If used improperly, this color has the potential of leaving color bands through your hair resulting in a color-corrective service. Always follow directions. This kit will last for up to 6 uses when used as directed.

In Your Kit: Non-latex Nitrile gloves, plastic cap, color bowl, color brush, tube of color, bottle of color developer, a comb, and these directions for your Touch-Up Kit.

- 1. Be sure you have your gloves on to protect your hands!
- 2. Mix ½ oz. color and ½ oz. developer in your color bowl. Mix color and developer thoroughly with your color brush. Always color hair in the bathroom and watch for any drops on the floor or counter during the application process.
- 3. Make sure your hair is dry and styled to your preferred part.
- 4. Apply your color on your part and hairline and press down to saturate all the hairs evenly.
- 5. Use you comb to gently blend your color out about ½ inch.
- 6. Processing times range from 20-30 minutes. Test color coverage by gently scraping the color off of an application spot.
- 7. Clean up any color spots on your skin using a paper towel or cotton pad with soap and water.
- 8. Once your color is processed, rinse color out very thoroughly, wash with shampoo, and apply your conditioner. You can do this at your kitchen sink or in your shower.
- 9. Be careful to not get the color in your eyes, if you do, flush your eye with water.
- 10. If you are a four week client it is advisable to Touch-Up at 2 weeks. If you are a six week client it is advisable to Touch-Up at 3 weeks.
