Application Instruction

Program Description: The Central Texas Feral Hog Task Force will provide **two** \$1,000 grants to Caldwell County landowners to support special projects designed to mitigate feral hog damage or advance technologies related to feral hog abatement in Caldwell County. Landowners hoping to qualify for this program should complete the form below along with a 2021 CTFHTF Feral Hog Damage and Control Survey. Applications will be scored by the grant selection committee based on need and merit of proposal.

Grant funds will be issued on a reimbursement basis. Signed receipts for any equipment or supplies purchased for this program will be submitted by the grantee to the Caldwell County Auditor for reimbursement of up to \$1,000. Grant funds will be released to the grantee for qualified expenditures within 30 days of certification. Applications for this program are due by 11:59pm, June 30, 2021.

Grant award recipients will be notified by July 8, 2021.
