NOTICE OF HEARING
June 9, 2016

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all interested persons in Fannin and Grayson Counties, Texas:

That the Board of Directors of the Red River Groundwater Conservation District (“District”) will hold a public hearing and accept public comment on the Desired Future Conditions proposed for the groundwater resources within the District. The proposed Desired Future Conditions for the District are as follows: Groundwater Management Area 8 aquifer-wide average drawdown through 2070 of (in feet): 146 in Woodbine; 144 in Paluxy; 116 in Glen Rose; 313 in Twin Mountain; 177 in Travis Peak; 118 in Hensell; 206 in Hosston; 177 in Antlers. District-wide average aquifer drawdown through 2070 of (in feet): 204 in Woodbine; 699 in Paluxy; 283 in Glen Rose; 377 in Twin Mountain; 269 in Travis Peak; 304 in Antlers. County-wide average aquifer drawdown through 2070 of (in feet): Fannin County - 247 in Woodbine, 688 in Paluxy, 280 in Glen Rose, 372 in Twin Mountain, 269 in Travis Peak, 251 in Antlers; Grayson County – 160 in Woodbine, 922 in Paluxy, 337 in Glen Rose, 417 in Twin Mountain, 348 in Antlers.

The District proposed the Desired Future Conditions for adoption as required by Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code with the other groundwater conservation districts in Groundwater Management Area 8. The other districts within Groundwater Management Area 8 include: Central Texas Groundwater Conservation District; Clearwater Underground Water Conservation District; Middle Trinity Groundwater Conservation District; North Texas Groundwater Conservation District; Northern Trinity Groundwater Conservation District; Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District; Prairielands Groundwater Conservation District; Saratoga Underground Water Conservation District; Southern Trinity Groundwater Conservation District; Upper Trinity Groundwater Conservation District.

The public hearing will be held on Thursday, June 9, 2016, at 2:00 p.m. at the Greater Texoma Utility Authority office, located at 5100 Airport Drive, Denison, Texas 75020. Comments on the proposed Desired Future Conditions may be presented in written or verbal form at the hearing. Written comments may also be submitted before or after the hearing by email at rrgcd@redrivergcd.org, by mail at P.O. Box 1214, Sherman, TX 75091, or in person at 5100 Airport Drive, Denison, TX 75020. Written comments will be accepted until 5:00 p.m. on July 12, 2016.

The District Board of Directors will also hold a Board meeting immediately following adjournment of the public hearing. Agenda items for the Board meeting include: Call to order, declare meeting open to public and take roll, public comment, approval of minutes, review and approval of monthly invoices, receive monthly financial information, update and possible action on process for the development of Desired Future Conditions, consider and act on compliance and enforcement activities for violation of District Rules, General Manager’s report (update on operational, educational, and other activities of District), open forum/discussion of new business for future meeting agendas, and adjourn meeting.
