BRING-A-FRIEND!!

Have a friend that would love to try a dance class? Bring them to your classes to dance with you for FREE! Monday September 26th - Saturday October 1st is "Bring-A-Friend-To-Dance Week". Show your friends/family what being an Impulse dancer is all about. Sign-up sheets will be at the front desk and must be signed by a parent/guardian. You must register your friends BEFORE bringing them to class. NOTE: "friends" must be within the age requirements to try any class.

CLASS VIEWING

Impulse is proud to offer a large class-viewing screen in our spacious lobby. Parents are able to observe classes without distracting our hardworking dancers. Please refrain from entering the dance studios during classes so we can provide a distraction-free learning environment. Teachers are available for questions in-between classes.

We also offer a special In-Class Observation Week:

Mon. Jan 16th - Sat. Jan 21st, 2017

During this week, guests can be inside the studios to watch our dancers in action.



ONLINE SYSTEM

You can register for classes, monitor your account (balance owing, upcoming due dates, fundraising credits, etc.), view your class schedule and more on Impulse's "Studio Director" online system. If you are officially registered at Impulse, your information is in the system and you can login from your mobile phone or computer.

To use Impulse's online system:

- 1. Go to www.impulseperformancearts.com and click on the REGISTER HERE tab OR use the following link:
 - https://www.thestudiodirector.com/impulsepe rformancearts/portal.jsp (add to your Bookmarks for future use!).
- 2. If this is your first time logging on, you will need to click "forgot your password?". Enter the email address you gave to Impulse when you registered and click NEXT. An email will be sent to you with a link to reset your password.
- 3. Once you receive the email from info@impulseperformance.com, you can click on the link or cut & paste the address into your internet browser.
- 4. Enter a new password of your choice for Impulse's online system. Login and check out your personalized account!

If you have any problems, give us a call or email and we'd be happy to help. We will be using this system to track all payments (tuition, costume deposits and balances, competition entry fees, fundraising credits etc.), to email notices and receipts (including income tax receipts) and to keep you up to date on new classes and workshops!

TUITION PAYMENTS

Upon registration, you were offered the choice of two tuition payment plans;

- (1) Season tuition paid in FULL, or
- (2) Season tuition broken into 10-equal installments due the 1st of each month (Sept. 1, 2016 June 1, 2017)
- *These are NOT pay-per-month payments. These installments are the full-year dance tuition divided into 10-equal payments.

Impulse accepts cash or email money transfer (due the 1st of each month) or cheque (please provide 10 post-dated cheques made out to "Impulse Performance Arts"). Please be sure to provide payment in a timely fashion as a \$25 late fee will be applied to all missed tuition installments. All cheques returned to Impulse as **NSF** will be charged a \$20.00 fee.

We will provide an emailed receipt for tax purposes in Jan/Feb 2017 (or upon request).

PARKING

Our parking lot is shared by all guests of our building: Impulse, United Family Martial Arts, etc.

- Enter the lot from Bell Ave ONLY (no entry off of King St)
- Drive slowly as there are lots of children entering/exiting the building
- If our lot is full, you may park in the Hamilton East Seventh-Day Adventist Church parking lot at 203 Bell Ave EXCEPT FOR WEDNESDAYS AND SATURDAYS
- There are parking spaces across the front of the building on King St. East.
- Do not park across the street at Pioneer Church; this is staff only parking.

"NO-SHOE POLICY"

Impulse strictly enforces a "No Outdoor Shoe"
Policy. All outdoor shoes MUST be removed on the mats upon entering Impulse and placed on designated shoe racks. Please help keep our dancers' feet clean and dry. Bring indoor shoes or slippers to wear at Impulse if you desire!



RECITAL AND COSTUME INFORMATION

Every year, Impulse dancers put on FABULOUS recital shows, and we can't wait to do it all over again in June 2017! Dates for the dress rehearsal and recital shows, theatre location and ticket information will be posted as soon as we have confirmation.

Every <u>recreational</u> class at Impulse will perform in our recital shows (even our littlest pre-dancers). This is a wonderful way for students to show off their new dance technique to family and friends...and, of course, enjoy some well-deserved time in the spotlight!

All classes require a recital costume and appropriate tights/footwear. A <u>\$40 non-refundable</u> costume deposit is required for <u>each</u> recreational recital costume and will be collected by November 30, 2016. Invoices will be posted to your online accounts. Competitive costumes require a \$50 non-refundable deposit and are due by October 31, 2016.

Impulse costumes are ordered and custom-made for each dancer (we take measurements during class). Costumes are made to fit the dancer perfectly for the recital shows. Final costume payments will be made when costumes arrive in May 2017. We aim to keep recreational class costumes between \$85.00 and \$100.00 each. Competitive costumes can range between \$110.00 - \$170.00 each.

Please note: clean tights and appropriate, clean footwear (ballet shoes, tap shoes, etc.) are supplied by the dancer/parent and are <u>NOT</u> included in the costume fee.



STUDENT ABSENCES/STUDIO CLOSURES

If a dancer needs to miss dance class, please call the studio to leave a message (905)548-9298 or email in advance. We worry if our dancers aren't in class!!

In the event of inclement weather/unsafe driving conditions, Impulse will make a decision to close the studio by 2:00pm. Emails will be sent out and notices posted on Facebook, Instagram, Twitter and voicemail. We will do our best to reschedule any cancelled classes due to unavoidable weather closures.

IMPULSE FASHION

Have you noticed some of our dancers wearing our custom-designed Impulse Bomber Jackets? Would you like one too? Order forms will be posted at the studio.

Jackets come in sizes Child 4 to Adult XXL.

Cost is approx. \$125.00/jacket. Payment must be received by Impulse staff in full before orders can be completed.

Note: All competitive students require a studio bomber jacket to wear over costumes at competitions.

Impulse also has amazing track pants, capri pants, hooded sweatshirts and t-shirts available in all sizes (children and adult). Information on purchasing studio gear will be posted soon!



IMPULSE DRESS CODE

Proper attire MUST be worn to **EVERY** class to keep dancers safe, comfortable, and to allow proper dance instruction! Warm-up gear (leg-warmers, sweatshirts, etc.) may be worn to BEGIN each class. Dance Happy Dancewear (134 London St S) and Step 'N Out Dancewear (1314 Upper Wentworth St) have our dress code on file and can help you find everything you need.

Please have long hair pulled back off the face for all classes. Buns are required for all ballet classes.

Impulse's full class dress code is posted on our website and on pg. 5 of this newsletter.

CHANGEROOMS & HOMEWORK AREA

Impulse has two large changerooms for our female dancers. Each changeroom has cubbies for bags, coats, clothing etc. and benches/chairs. Our male dancers can change in our spacious large washroom. Our designated quiet HOMEWORK zone is located in Changeroom #2 and we encourage students to use this area to complete schoolwork during dance class breaks!

WATER & SNACKS

We encourage all dancers to bring their own water/water bottles to classes. Water bottles can be purchased from the office for \$1 if you forget. If bringing snacks or dinner to the studio, please consider nut-free products as we aim to keep our space safe for those with allergies.

LOST & FOUND

A lost & found bin is kept in Changeroom #2. All clothing, dance shoes, water bottles etc found around the studio will be placed in this bin until they are claimed. Please check frequently as we often donate these lost items to avoid overflow!
