Daily Prayer

Lord, I confess that sometimes I allow myself to become discouraged and not fully trust that you are with me or are working for me. As a man once responded to Jesus, “I believe, Lord, help my unbelief”. Amen.

Monday, 11/04 Philippians 1:3-6

Sometimes it seems that we get an idea of what God is calling us to do, but then it is almost a struggle to achieve it. We then begin to question if this was really a call from God. Reread this passage again. How do you feel having the assurance that God will do good work through you?

Tuesday, 11/05 Proverbs 3:5-6

It is very easy to rely on our own knowledge and experience. After all, we are taught to be self-reliant. Yet this passage seems to be saying something very different. How often do you fully rely on God and not yourself?

Wednesday, 11/06 2 Peter 3:8-9

Time seems to move so slow when we are waiting for something good to happen. For God’s Kingdom to be restored seems to be so far off that we don’t even pay it much mind. But what if God is calling for you to make Heaven on Earth to be here and now?

Thursday, 11/07 Exodus 3:7-9

The ancient Hebrews had given up hope. Generations had passed since they felt God’s favor. Yet, God had not forgotten them. A new promise arose. How does this promise of a new era of favor speak to you today?

Friday, 11/08 Isaiah 65:24-25

Reread verse 24. What do you find remarkable about it? How does this shift your understanding of God’s grace and providence towards you?
