Pastor's Portion

At Bloomer Baptist this winter, we have several Ladies Bible Studies focusing on a book that deals with anxiety. In the Sermon on the Mount a paragraph is dedicated to anxiety. While Luke's account of the sermon on the plain does not include that paragraph I would like to focus on just one verse that concludes the words of Jesus on that issue.

Matthew 6:33 (ESV) says: "But seek first the kingdom of God and his right-eousness, and all these things will be added to you." Let's start with thinking about the first word, "but" and the phrase "all these things." This statement of Jesus serves as a contrast to what has proceeded. The "all these things" refers to eating, clothes to wear (verses 28, 31) and life (verse 25). Jesus again hits the issues of life square on the head. We fret and fume over appearances and stock markets; jobs and checkbooks; kids and politics. The big "but" lets us know God has a better plan that is in sharp contrast to our nature. The solution is the core of the verse.

"Seek first," Jesus says. Seek has the concept of intensity. Life has a way of dishing out stuff that can be distracting. Jesus calls us to focus our energies, mind and emotion on the important issues.

"First" has a couple of ideas as I see it. It speaks to priority and chronology. Jesus invites us to see the *Kingdom of God* as a priority in our lives. Jesus and John the Baptist proclaimed the Kingdom of God was at hand. We pray, "Thy Kingdom come" as the first request in the Lord's Prayer. A Kingdom is made up of three things: 1) A people; 2) A ruler; 3) A system. You need all three to have a Kingdom. The point is when we make a priority Kingdom seeking then the usual suspects that cause anxiety will diminish. We will focus on God's people, the King Jesus and His rule on earth.

"First" also has the idea of chronology. Instead of prayer and seeking God as our last resort it should be our first plan of attack. So the challenge is to have God at the front of the line instead of last resort.

"His righteousness" speaks to the system of God ruling on earth. Jeremiah 9:24 says God delights in **steadfast love**, **justice and righteousness in the earth.** Steadfast is the sense of not just a flash in the pan but the long road of love, justice and righteousness. God gives just enough turmoil in our existence to reveal how wonderful and immutable He is. (Immutable means unchangeable).

Then the promise, "all these things will be added to you." "These things then are eating, wearing and life. God promises are kept. He is strong and faithful. We serve a God that has our best interests at heart.

So a word of encouragement: Put to memory Matthew 6:33. Learn from it and practice it. You will be eternally grateful.
