


The Land of First Inheritance or The Land of Promise



- 1.1st Nephi 18:23-25 "... And it came to pass that after we had sailed for the space of many days we did arrive at the promised land; and we went forth upon the land, and did pitch our tents; and we did call it the promised land. And it came to pass that we did begin to till the earth, and we began to plant seeds; yea, we did put all our seeds into the earth, which we had brought from the land of Jerusalem. And it came to pass that they did grow exceedingly; wherefore, we were blessed in abundance. And it came to pass that we did find upon the land of promise, as we journeyed in the wilderness, that there were beasts in the forests of every kind, both the cow and the ox, and the ass and the horse, and the goat and the wild goat, and all manner of wild animals, which were for the use of men. And we did find all manner of ore, both of gold, and of silver, and of copper."
- 2. 2nd Nephi 5:5-8 "...the Lord did warn me, that I, Nephi, should depart from them and flee into the wilderness, and all those who would go with me....And we did take our tents and whatsoever things were possible for us, and did journey in the wilderness for the space of many days. And after we had journeyed for the space of many days we did pitch our tents...And my people would that we should call the name of the place Nephi..."


Mosiah leaves to the land Northward



- 1. Omni 1:12 "Behold, I am Amaleki, the son of Abinadom. Behold, I will speak unto you somewhat concerning Mosiah, who was made king over the land of Zarahemla; for behold, he being warned of the Lord that he should flee out of the land of Nephi, and as many as would hearken unto the voice of the Lord should also depart out of the land with him, into the wilderness—
- 2. Omni 1:14 "And they discovered a people, who were called the people of Zarahemla. Now, there was great rejoicing among the people of Zarahemla; and also Zarahemla did rejoice exceedingly, because the Lord had sent the people of Mosiah with the plates of brass which contained the record of the Jews."


The Journey's back to the Land of Nephi



- 1. Omni 1:27 "...I would speak somewhat concerning a certain number who went up into the wilderness to return to the land of Nephi..."
- 2. Omni 1:28 "...they went up into the wilderness...and they were all slain, save fifty, in the wilderness, and they returned again to the land of Zarahemla."
- **3.** Omni 1:29 "...they also took others...and took their journey again into the wilderness."
- **4. Omni 1:30** "...I have not since known concerning them..." **Mosiah 9:6** "...(Zeniff) went in unto the king, and...covenanted...that (they) might possess the land of Lehi-Nephi, and...Shilom..."
- 5. Mosiah 7:2-3 "And it came to pass that king Mosiah granted that sixteen of their strong men might go up to the land of Lehi-Nephi, to inquire concerning their brethren..."
- **6. Mosiah 7:4** "And now, they knew not the course they should travel in the wilderness to go up to the land of Lehi-Nephi; therefore they wandered...forty days..."
- 7. Mosiah 7:5 "And when they had wandered forty days they came to a hill, which is north of the land of Shilom, and there they pitched their tents."
- **8. Mosiah 7:6** "And Ammon took three of his brethren, and their names were Amaleki, Helem, and Hem, and they went down into the land of Nephi."
- 9. Mosiah 7:7-14 "...they met the king of the people who were in the land of Nephi, and in the land of Shilom; and they were surrounded by the king's guard, and were taken...and were committed to prison. And it came to pass when they had been in prison two days they were again brought before the king... And he said unto them: Behold, I am Limhi, the son of Noah, who was the son of Zeniff, who came up out of the land of Zarahemla to inherit this land..."


Alma and Limhi seek Zarahemla



- **1. Mosiah 21:25-26** "...king Limhi had sent...a small number of men to search for the land of Zarahemla; but they could not find it, and they were lost in the wilderness...they did find a land which had been peopled...covered with dry bones...they...supposed it to be the land of Zarahemla, returned to the land of Nephi..."
- 2. Mosiah 23:1-4,19 "...Alma, having been warned of the Lord that the armies of king Noah would come upon them...departed into the wilderness before the armies of king Noah. And they came to a land, yea, even a very beautiful and pleasant land...(and) began to prosper exceedingly in the land...they called...Helam."
- **3. Mosiah 23:30-34** "...the armies of the Lamanites...had been lost in the wilderness for many days...and...they had found those priests of king Noah, in a place which they called Amulon...and the Lamanites had compassion...and did not destroy them, because of their wives."
- **4. Mosiah 23:35** "...And Amulon and his brethren did join the Lamanites, and...they discovered the land of Helam, which was possessed by Alma and his brethren."
- 5. Mosiah 23:36 "...the Lamanites promised unto Alma and his brethren, that if they would show them the way which led to the land of Nephi that they would grant unto them their lives..."
- 6. Mosiah 24:25 "...after they had been in the wilderness twelve days they arrived in the land of Zarahemla; and king Mosiah did also receive them with joy."
- 7. Mosiah 22:11-13 "...Limhi did depart. ...towards the land of Zarahemla, being led by Ammon and his brethren...and...they arrived in the land of Zarahemla..."


Alma's Missionary Journey



- 1. Alma 5:1 "NOW it came to pass that Alma began to deliver the word of God unto the people, first in the land of Zarahemla...."
- 2. Alma 6:7 "And now it came to pass that when Alma had made these regulations he departed from them, ... and went over upon the east of the river Sidon, into the valley of Gideon, there having been a city built, which was called the city of Gideon..."
- 3. Alma 8:1 "AND now it came to pass that Alma returned from the land of Gideon...he returned to his own house at Zarahemla to rest himself from the labors which he had performed."
- **4. Alma 8:3** "And it came to pass in the commencement of the tenth year of the reign of the judges over the people of Nephi, that Alma departed from thence and took his journey over into the land of Melek, on the west of the river Sidon, on the west by the borders of the wilderness."
- 5. Alma 8:13 "Now when the people had said this... and caused that he should be cast out of their city, he departed thence and took his journey towards the city which was called Aaron."
- **6. Alma 8:18** "Now it came to pass that after Alma had received his message from the angel of the Lord he returned speedily to the land of Ammonihah..."
- 7. Alma 15:1 "AND it came to pass that Alma and Amulek were commanded to depart out of that city; and they departed, and came out even into the land of Sidom..."
- 8. Alma 15:18 "Now as I said, Alma having seen all these things, therefore he took Amulek and came over to the land of Zarahemla..."


Alma's refuge and the escape of King Noah



- 1. Mosiah 18:1-6 "...Alma, who had fled from the servants of king Noah,...and...many as did believe him did go forth to a place which was called Mormon, having received its name from the king, being in the borders of the land having been infested, by times or at seasons, by wild beasts."
- 2. Mosiah 18:33 "...the king said that Alma was stirring up the people to rebellion against him; therefore he sent his army to destroy them."
- 3. Mosiah 18:34 "...Alma and the people of the Lord were apprised of the coming of the king's army; therefore they took their tents and their families and departed into the wilderness."
- **4. Mosiah 19:1** "...the army...returned, having searched in vain for the people of the Lord."
- 5. Mosiah 19:6 "...the king cast his eyes round about towards the land of Shemlon, and behold, the army of the Lamanites were within the borders of the land."
- **6. Mosiah 19:9** "...the king commanded...that they should flee before the Lamanites, and he himself did go before them...with their women and their children."
- 7. Mosiah 19:10,15 "...the Lamanites did pursue them, and did overtake them, and began to slay them...and took them captives and carried them back to the land of Nephi..."
- 8. Mosiah 20:1-5 "...there was a place in Shemlon where the daughters of the Lamanites did gather ...to make themselves merry...the priests of king Noah, being ashamed to return to the city of Nephi, ...discovered the daughters of the Lamanites...and took them and carried them into the wilderness..."

Alma Chapter 16

Lamanite attack on Ammonihah



- 3. Alma 16:2 "...the armies of the Lamanites had come in upon the wilderness side, into the borders of the land, even into the city of Ammonihah, and began to slay the people and destroy the city."
- **4. Alma 16:3** "they had destroyed the people who were in the city of Ammonihah, and also some around the borders of Noah, and taken others captive into the wilderness.
- 5. Alma 16:6 "...the Lamanites will cross the river Sidon in the south wilderness, away up beyond the borders of the land of Manti..."
- 6. Alma 16:7 "...Zoram and his sons crossed over the river Sidon, with their armies, and marched away beyond the borders of Manti into the south wilderness, which was on the east side of the river Sidon."
- 7. Alma 16:8 "...they came upon the armies of the Lamanites, and the Lamanites were scattered and driven into the wilderness..."

Alma Chapter 22-23

The Land of the Lamanites vs. the Anti-Nephi-Lehi



- 1. Alma 22:28-29 "...the Nephites had taken possession of all the northern parts of the land bordering on the wilderness, at the head of the river Sidon, from the east to the west, round about on the wilderness side; on the north, even until they came to the land which they called Bountiful."
- 2. Alma 22:28-29 "Now, the more idle part of the Lamanites lived in the wilderness, and dwelt in tents; and they were spread through the wilderness on the west, in the land of Nephi; yea, and also on the west of the land of Zarahemla, in the borders by the seashore, and on the west in the land of Nephi, in the place of their fathers' first inheritance, and thus bordering along by the seashore. And also there were many Lamanites on the east by the seashore, whither the Nephites had driven them. And thus the Nephites were nearly surrounded by the Lamanites..."
- 3. Alma 23:8-9 "...they who were converted unto the Lord...were in the land of Ishmael"
- 4. Alma 23:8,10 "...they who were converted unto the Lord...were in the land of Middoni"
- **5.** Alma 23:8,11 "...they who were converted unto the Lord...were in the city of Nephi"
- **6.** Alma 23:8,12 "...they who were converted unto the Lord...were in the land of Shilom"
- 7. Alma 23:8,12 "...they who were converted unto the Lord...were in the land of Shemlon"
- 8. Alma 23:8,12 "...they who were converted unto the Lord...(were) in the city of Lemuel"
- 9. Alma 23:8,12 "...they who were converted unto the Lord...(were) in the city of Shimnilom"

Korihor



- 1. Alma 30:6 "...there came a man into the land of Zarahemla, and he was Anti-Christ..."
- 2. Alma 30:19 "...Now this man went over to the land of Jershon also, to preach these things among the people of Ammon, who were once the people of the Lamanites.
- **3.** Alma 30:21 "...he caused that he should be carried out of the land. And he came over into the land of Gideon, and began to preach unto them..."
- **4. Alma 30:29** "...they delivered him up into the hands of the officers, and sent him to the land of Zarahemla, that he might be brought before Alma, and the chief judge who was governor over all the land..."
- 5. Alma 30:59 "And it came to pass that as he went forth among the people, yea, among a people who had separated themselves from the Nephites and called themselves Zoramites, being led by a man whose name was Zoram—and as he went forth amongst them, behold, he was run upon and trodden down, even until he was dead." Alma 31:3 "Now the Zoramites had gathered themselves together in a land which they called Antionum, which was east of the land of Zarahemla, which lay nearly bordering upon the seashore, which was south of the land of Jershon, which also bordered upon the wilderness south, which wilderness was full of the Lamanites."


The Mission of the Sons of Mosiah



- **1.** Alma 17:7 "...they departed out of the land of Zarahemla..."
- 2. Alma 17:19 "...Ammon went to the land of Ishmael...after the sons of Ishmael, who...became Lamanites."
- 3. Alma 21:1 "...Ammon and his brethren separated themselves in the borders of the land of the Lamanites, behold Aaron took his journey towards...Jerusalem...joining the borders of Mormon."
- 4. Alma 21:11 "...he departed...and came over to a village which was called Ani-Anti, and there he found Muloki...and also Ammah and his brethren..."
- **5.** Alma 21:12 "...they departed and came over into the land of Middoni..."
- **6.** Alma 20:3 "...Ammon...said...Behold, my...brethren are in prison at Middoni, and I go..."
- 7. Alma 20:8 "...as Ammon and Lamoni were journeying thither, they met the father of Lamoni..."
- 8. No scripture shows Lamoni's father returned home, but he was at Nephi when Aaron visited.
- 9. Alma 21:18 "... Ammon & Lamoni returned from the land of Middoni to the land of Ishmael..."
- 10. Alma 22:1 "Aaron & his brethren...departed...the land of Middoni...to the land of Nephi..."
- 11. Alma 23:4 "... Aaron and his brethren went forth from city to city... establishing churches..."
- 12. Alma 27:14 "... they gathered together all their people... and departed out of the land..."
- 13. Alma 17:1 "...Alma was journeying from the land of Gideon southward, away to the land of Manti...he met with the sons of Mosiah journeying towards the land of Zarahemla." (also Alma 27:16)
- **14.** Alma 27:15 "... I and my brethren will go forth into the land of Zarahemla..."
- 15. Alma 27:26 "...they went down into the land of Jershon..."
- 16. Alma 27:26 "...they...took possession of...Jershon; and ...were called...the people of Ammon"


The Mission to the Zoramites



- 1. Alma 31:5-7 "...Alma ...took Ammon, and Aaron, and Omner; and Himni he did leave in the church in Zarahemla; but the former three he took with him, and also Amulek and Zeezrom, who were at Melek; and he also took two of his sons...Shiblon and Corianton...and...went...among the Zoramites..."
- 2. Alma 32:4 "...Alma was teaching and speaking unto the people upon the hill Onidah, there came a great multitude unto him..."
- **3. Alma 35:1,6** "...they withdrew themselves from the multitude and came over into the land of Jershon... those who were in favor of the words which had been spoken by Alma and his brethren were cast out of the land; and they were many; and they came over also into the land of Jershon."
- **4. Alma 35:14** "...Alma, and Ammon, and their brethren, and also the two sons of Alma returned to the land of Zarahemla, after having been instruments in the hands of God of bringing many of the Zoramites to repentance; and as many as were brought to repentance were driven out of their land; but they have lands for their inheritance in the land of Jershon, and they have taken up arms to defend themselves, and their wives, and children, and their lands."


The Battle between the Nephites and the Lamanites



- 1. Alma 43:18 "...he met the Lamanites in the borders of Jershon, and his people were armed..."
- 2. Alma 43:22 "...they departed out of the land of Antionum into the wilderness...by the head of the river Sidon, that they might come into the land of Manti..."
- 3. Alma 43:23 "... Moroni sent spies into the wilderness to watch their camp..."
- **4.** Alma 43:25 "...Moroni, leaving a part of his army in the land of Jershon, took the remaining part of his army and marched over into the land of Manti."
- 5. Alma 43:27 "...Moroni caused that his army...be secreted in the valley...near the...river Sidon, which was on the west of the river Sidon in the wilderness."
- 6. Alma 43:31 "...he divided his army...and concealed them on the east..."
- 7. Alma 43:31,35 "...he divided his army...south of the hill Riplah...led by a man...Lehi..."
- 8. Alma 43:34-35 "the Lamanites came up on the north of the hill...passed the hill Riplah, and came into the valley, and began to cross the river Sidon..."
- 9. Alma 43:35 "Lehi...encircled the Lamanites about on the east in their rear."
- 10. Alma 43:40 "...pursued by Lehi and his men; and they were driven...into the waters of Sidon...and Lehi retained his armies upon the bank of the river Sidon that they should not cross."
- 11. Alma 43:41 "Moroni and his army met the Lamanites in the valley, on the other side of the river Sidon, and began to fall upon them and to slay them."
- 12. Alma 43:42 "...the Lamanites did flee...towards the land of Manti; and...were met again..."
- 13. Alma 44:15 "...as many as entered into a covenant...depart(ed) into the wilderness...
- 14. Alma 44:23 "...the armies of the Nephites...returned and came to their houses and their lands."

Alma Chapter 48-50


King Amalickiah tries to invade the Land of the Nephites



- 1. Alma 48:6 "...they took their camp, and moved forth toward the land of Zarahemla..."
- 2. Alma 49:1,11 "...the armies of the Lamanites were seen approaching towards the land of Ammonihah... (they) durst not attack the Nephites at the city of Ammonihah...the Lamanites were disappointed in their places of retreat and they could not come upon them."
- 3. Alma 49:12,21 "...they retreated into the wilderness, and took their camp and marched towards the land of Noah, supposing that to be the next best place for them to come against the Nephites... the...Lamanites brought up their armies before the place of entrance, and began to contend with the Nephites...but behold, they were driven back (and)...slain with an immense slaughter."
- **4. Alma 49:25** "...when the Lamanites saw that their chief captains were all slain they fled into the wilderness. And it came to pass that they returned to the land of Nephi, to inform their king, Amalickiah, who was a Nephite by birth, concerning their great loss."
- 5. Alma 50:7 "...Moroni caused that his armies should go forth into the east wilderness; yea, and they went forth and drove all the Lamanites who were in the east wilderness into their own lands, which were south of the land of Zarahemla."

Alma Chapters 35

Preparations for Battle between the Nephites and the Zoramites



- 1. Alma 35:8 "...the Zoramites were angry with the people of Ammon who were in Jershon, and the chief ruler of the Zoramites, being a very wicked man, sent over unto the people of Ammon desiring them that they should cast out of their land all those who came over from them into their land..."
- 2. Alma 35:10 "the Zoramites...began to mix with the Lamanites and to stir them up also to anger against them..."
- 3. Alma 35:13 "...the people of Ammon departed out of the land of Jershon, and came over into the land of Melek..."
- **4. Alma 35:13** They "...gave place in the land of Jershon for the armies of the Nephites, that they might contend with the armies of the Lamanites and the armies of the Zoramites..."
- **5.** Alma 35:13 "...thus commenced a war betwixt the Lamanites and the Nephites..."

Alma Chapters 45-47


Amalickiah flees the Nephites and becomes King of the Lamanites



- 1. Alma 45:18 "...when Alma had done this he departed out of the land of Zarahemla, as if to go into the land of Melek...he was never heard of more; as to his death or burial we know not of."
- 2. Alma 46:29 "...he (Amalickiah) took those of his people...and departed into the land of Nephi."
- 3. Alma 46:31 "...Moroni...took his army and marched out with his tents into the wilderness, to cut off the course of Amalickiah in the wilderness."
- **4. Alma 46:33 & Alma 47:1** "...Amalickiah fled with a small number of his men...and went up in the land of Nephi among the Lamanites..."
- 5. Alma 46:33 "...the remainder were delivered up into the hands of Moroni and were taken back into the land of Zarahemla."
- 6. Alma 47:5 "...those who were not obedient...fled to Onidah, to the place of arms."
- 7. Alma 47:5 "...he (Amalickiah) had got the command of those parts of the Lamanites who were in favor of the king; and he sought to gain favor of those who were not obedient; therefore he went forward to the place which was called Onidah..."
- **8.** Alma 47:7-9 "...they had gathered themselves...upon the top of the mount...called Antipas...he (Amalickiah) caused his army to pitch their tents in the valley which was near the mount Antipas."
- 9. Alma 47:29 "...when the servants of the king saw an army pursuing after them, they...came over into the land of Zarahemla and joined the people of Ammon."
- **8.** Alma 47:31 "...he (Amalickiah) entered the city Nephi with his armies, and took possession..."

Alma Chapter 51


King Amalickiah's 2nd Invasion



- 1. Alma 51:22-23 "...the Lamanites had come into the land of Moroni, which was in the borders by the seashore...the Nephites were not sufficiently strong in the city of Moroni...Amalickiah took possession of the city..."
- 2. Alma 51:24 "...those who fled out of the city of Moroni came to the city of Nephihah..."
- 3. Alma 51:26 "...he (Amalickiah) went on, taking possession of many cities, the city of Nephihah, and the city of Lehi, and the city of Morianton, and the city of Omner, and the city of Gid, and the city of Mulek, all of which were on the east borders by the seashore..."
- **4. Alma 51:28-29** "...they marched to the borders of the land Bountiful, driving the Nephites before them and slaying many. But it came to pass that they were met by Teancum..."

Alma Chapters 52


The Nephites recapture Mulek from the Lamanites



- 1. Alma 52:22 "...he caused that Teancum should take a small number of men and march down near the seashore..."
- 2. Alma 52:22 "...Moroni and his army...marched in the wilderness...west of the city Mulek..."
- 3. Alma 52:23 "...the Lamanites did march forth against Teancum, supposing by their numbers to overpower Teancum because of the smallness of his numbers..."
- **4. Alma 52:23** "... Teancum saw the armies of the Lamanites coming out against him he began to retreat down by the seashore, northward."
- 5. Alma 52:24 "...while Teancum was thus leading away the Lamanites who were pursuing them in vain, behold, Moroni commanded that a part of his army who were with him should march forth into the city, and take possession of it."
- 6. Alma 52:27 "...the Lamanites did pursue Teancum until they came near the city Bountiful, and then they were met by Lehi and a small army..."
- 7. Alma 52:28 "...the Lamanites had beheld Lehi with his army coming against them, they fled in much confusion, lest...they should not obtain the city Mulek before Lehi should overtake them..."
- **8.** Alma 52:26 "...Moroni...marched...to meet the Lamanites when they should return from the pursuit of Teancum..."
- 9. Alma 52:39 "...their weapons of war were taken from them, and they were compelled to march with their brethren forth into the land Bountiful."

Alma Chapters 50


Dispute between the Cities of Lehi and Morianton



- 1. Alma 50:26 "...the people who possessed the land of Morianton did claim a part of the land of Lehi...insomuch that the people of Morianton took up arms against their brethren..."
- 2. Alma 50:27 "..the people who possessed the land of Lehi fled to the camp of Moroni..."
- 3. Alma 50:29 "... Morianton put it into their hearts that they should flee to the land which was northward, which was covered with large bodies of water, and take possession of the land which was northward."
- 4. Alma 50:33-34 "...Moroni sent an army, with their camp, to head the people of Morianton, to stop their flight into the land northward. And it came to pass that they did not head them until they had come to the borders of the land Desolation; and there they did head them, by the narrow pass which led by the sea into the land northward, yea, by the sea, on the west and on the east."
- 5. Alma 50:35 "...the army which was sent by Moroni, which was led by a man whose name was Teancum, did meet the people of Morianton...Teancum did slay Morianton and defeat his army, and took them prisoners, and returned to the camp of Moroni..."

Alma Chapter 55-57

Moroni recaptures Gid, Helaman fights in the Land west of Manti




- 1. Alma 55:16,24 "...Moroni...went to the city Gid, while the Lamanites were...deep sleep and drunken...He...took possession of the city...the prisoners...did join the army of Moroni..."
- 2. Alma 56:13-14 "...And now these are the cities of which the Lamanites have obtained...The land of Manti, or the city of Manti...Zeezrom...Cumeni, and...Antiparah..."
- 3. Alma 56:9 "..., Helaman, did march at the head of these two thousand young men to the city of Judea, to assist Antipus..."
- **4.** Alma 56:31 "...we were to march near the city of Antiparah, as if...going to the city beyond..."
- 5. Alma 56:35 "...they (the Lamanites) came forth with their army and marched against us.."
- 6. Alma 56:33 "... Antipus did march...his army, leaving the remainder to maintain the city..."
- 7. Alma 56:49 "... Antipus had overtaken them, and a terrible battle had commenced..."
- **8.** Alma **56:42** "...they did not pursue us far before they halted..."
- 9. Alma 56:52,55 "...the Lamanites pursu(ed) them (Antipus' Army)...when Helaman came upon their rear...and began to slay them exceedingly...they had surrendered themselves up unto us..."
- 10. Alma 56:57 "...our prisoners...we sent them to the land of Zarahemla, and a part of those men who were not slain of Antipus..."
- 11. Alma 56:57 "...the remainder I...joined...to my...Ammonites, and took...to the city of Judea."
- 12. Alma 57:11-12 "the Lamanites being cut off from their support...began to lose all hopes of succor; therefore they yielded up the city unto our hands; and thus we...obtain(ed) city Cumeni."
- 13. Alma 57:4 "...the people of Antiparah did leave the city...(and) Antiparah fell into our hands."

Alma Chapter 61 & 62

Moroni Marches to Zarahemla &


the Nephites take Nephihah, Lehi, Omner, Morianton & Moroni



- 1. Alma 61:5 "...they (kings-men) have driven me (Pahoran) out before them, and I have fled to the land of Gideon, with as many men as it were possible...)
- 2. Alma 62:3 "...Moroni took a small number of men, according to the desire of Pahoran, and gave Lehi and Teancum command over the remainder of his army, and took his march towards the land of Gideon..."


Hagoth goes North & Coriantumr invades the Nephites



- Alma 63:5 "...Hagoth...went forth and built him an exceedingly large ship, on the borders of the land Bountiful, by the land Desolation, and launched it forth into the west sea, by the narrow neck which led into the land northward."
- 2. Helaman 1:17 "...he did appoint Coriantum to be their leader, and did cause that they should march down to the land of Zarahemla to battle against the Nephites."
- **3. Helaman 1:23** "...he (Coriantumr) did not tarry in the land of Zarahemla, but he did march forth with a large army, even towards the city of Bountiful..."


The conquest of Manti


The Lamanites move the borders
