LANDSCAPING NOTES

Welcome Fall. Even though the temperatures are still warm, Fall is here. The Chantarelle community made it through summer without many problems. Irrigation issues occurred but that is to be expected with the age of our system. Our Waldron crew was right on top of the problems and attended to them quickly.

Watering of the lawns will begin to be cut back starting with the first week of October. We are going to cut back to 5 nights a week and monitor the effect. The lawns were treated for grubs this season and many of the brown patches have disappeared and they look green and healthy.

Plans are being finalized for our Fall planting project. Ben and I appreciated the input we received from our neighbors requesting an update to their front planting. We enjoy working with everyone and we look forward to seeing the new looks around the community. We would like to mention the dreaded back flow issue. We are part of the committee working on the back flow covers and as was mentioned at the HOA meeting no final decisions are being made until all the devices are in place and we know exactly what we are dealing with. We are committed to making these devices as visually appealing as possible. Each area will be different and as such different solutions will be considered. Please know that we are very concerned with this issue and will be working closely with the committee to come up with aesthetically

pleasing solution.
