- I. **Meeting:** Meeting called to order at 6:35 pm. October 2017 meeting notes were motioned for approval by Mike Biezad & seconded by Carolyn Morales; motion passed unanimously.

- III. **League Commissioner Report:**
 - A. KCSF Meeting Report:

B. Maria Sandoval, a U19 player with BRYSL, asked the board if BRYSL would be willing to sponsor the South High girls soccer program. The sponsorship will help cover the cost of tournament fees and general upkeep to their department. With the sponsorship, BRYSL will get their logo on the sleeve of the South High soccer t-shirts, a banner at home games, and flyers about BRYSL will be passed out at home games as well.
