  - 11.1. Spoke about the possibility of 18 storms this time and be prepared to be an operator


- 11.2. Don't need to have formal training but a three-hour online info/course would make understanding things much better

- **18.** Next meeting will be on September 21<sup>th</sup> same time, same location Respectfully Submitted by Donna KC3IHV


