## Revised 1976 Federal Pee Dee Roll Requirements for Enrollment

Applicants must satisfy ALL of the below criteria in order to be included on the Revised 1976 Federal Pee Dee Roll. All individuals not included on the Revised 1976 Federal Pee Dee Roll will cease to be enrolled in the Pee Dee Indian Tribe effective 07/03/2018. The Revised 1976 Federal Pee Dee Roll will supersede and void all previous Pee Dee tribal rolls. Once the Revised 1976 Federal Pee Dee Roll has been finalized, all future Pee Dee Indian Tribe applicants will be required to prove direct ancestry to an individual listed on the Revised 1976 Federal Pee Dee Roll in order to be eligible for enrollment.

- \*Applicant must be a currently enrolled member of the Pee Dee Indian Tribe as of 03/11/2018.
- \*Applicant must be 18 years of age or older.
- \*Applicant must submit a completed copy of Form RPDR-1 to the Pee Dee Indian Tribe no later than 07/02/2018.
- \*Applicant must not have a direct ancestor already listed on the Revised 1976 Federal Pee Dee Roll. Any applicant with a direct ancestor listed on the Revised 1976 Federal Pee Dee Roll will be able to submit an updated "General Application for Enrollment" once the Revised 1976 Federal Pee Dee Roll enrollment process has been finalized.
- \*Applicant must have sufficient American Indian/Pee Dee genealogical documentation in their enrollment file as determined by the Government of the Pee Dee Indian Tribe (birth/death certificates, marriage licenses, census documents, obituaries, tribal roll numbers, etc.). DNA ancestry tests and "family stories" will NOT be accepted as proof of Pee Dee/American Indian identity. Any applicant files that are found to have insufficient documentation will result in the applicant being denied enrollment. Applicants who are denied enrollment due to insufficient documentation in their enrollment files will be given 30 days from the date of denial to submit sufficient Pee Dee/American Indian genealogical documentation as determined by the Government of the Pee Dee Indian Tribe in order for their denied status to be reevaluated.
