

## EQUITATION DIVISIONS

To be judged on position, performance, control of mount and correct style.

**Leadline** - Open to children 7 yrs and younger. May not cross enter into any other classes. Ties for Champion or Reserve will go to the rider with the most points in the WT class.

**Walk-Trot** - Open to riders of any age who have not yet shown at the canter in a horse show. May cross enter into any other WT classes as eligible.

**Short Stirrup Equitation** - Riders 10 yrs and under. To show over crossrails.

**Beginner Rider Equitation** - Open to riders of any age in their first or second year of showing. To show over crossrails. Trotting anywhere on course permitted.

**Junior/Amateur Equitation** - Open to junior and adult amateur riders. Fences 2' for ponies, 2'6" for horses.

## HUNTER DIVISIONS

To be judged on performance, manners and way of going.

**Short Stirrup Hunter** - Riders 10 yrs and under, a simple course over crossrails. May not enter a division to jump higher than 2'.

**Modified Hunter** - Open to all horses and ponies ridden by junior or adult amateur riders. Fences 2'.

**Low Children's Hunter Pony** - Open to Junior riders on ponies. All ponies jump 2'. Rider may not cross enter into the Children's Hunter divisions.

**Low Children's Hunter Horse** - Open to Junior riders on horses. Fences 2'6". Rider may not cross enter into Children's Hunter divisions.

**Low Adult Amateur Hunter** - Open to Adult Amateur riders. Fences 2'6". Rider may not cross enter into Adult Amateur Hunter.

**Children's Hunter** - Open to junior riders. May not cross enter into Pre-Children's Hunter. Horses 2'9", Large ponies 2'6", Small/Medium ponies 2'.

**Adult Amateur Hunter** - Open to Adult Amateur riders. All to jump 2'9". May not cross enter into Low/Pre-Adult Amateur Hunter.

**Developing Hunter** - Open to all horses and ponies starting training in the hunter division. Trotting anywhere on course permitted. To show over crossrails with groundlines.

**Baby Green Hunter** - Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences, who have not shown over fences 2'9" or higher. Section A: 2', Section B: 2'6". Simple changes of lead not to be penalized. May be split into two divisions if entries warrant.

**Thoroughbred Hunter** - Open to any registered and non-registered thoroughbreds. Fences 2'3".

**Low Hunter** - Open to all horses and ponies to be ridden by juniors, adults or professionals. Fences 2'6"-2'9".

## PLEASURE DIVISIONS

Judged on manners, suitability, performance and kindness.

Division will be split if entries warrant either by horse and pony, or junior and adult rider.

**Pleasure Horse or Pony** - Open to all riders of any age or qualification on a horse or pony. Division to be a walk-trot class, a walk-trot canter class and a class of a simple course at 2' without oxers.

**From PA Tnpk Harrisburg:**

Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 22 (Morgantown). Follow Route 10 South. At the stop sign, turn left onto Route 23. The farm is 6.5 miles on the right.

**From PA Tnpk Philadelphia:**

Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 23 (Downingtown). Follow Route 100 North to Route 401 West. Turn right onto Route 345, at the stop sign turn right onto Route 23. The farm is 1 mile on the right.

**From Route 422:**

Take Route 100 South towards West Chester. Turn right onto Route 23. The farm is approx. 5 miles on the left.

**From Rt. 78:**

Take Rt. 78 to Route 100 South to turn right onto Route 23. The farm is approx. 5 miles on the left.

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

### ENTRY FEES

\$25.00 per class, \$30.00 Medal

A \$40 Grounds/EMT Fee will be charged per entry.

A \$10 Schooling Fee will be charged per entry.

**Entries close at 9:00 pm on Thursday, May 9th.**

Post entries of additional horses, if time permits, will be charged \$20.00 per horse.

No same-day walk-in entries can be accepted. Changes to an existing entry are of course permitted. Divisions will be split or combined as entries warrant.

All divisions will pin a Champion and Reserve Champion.

### SCHOOLING

The show rings will be open on the morning of the show from 7:00 am to 7:45 am, and at appropriate breaks between divisions. Schooling sessions will be supervised by show staff.

### USHJA OUTREACH \* PHSA

All sections qualify for the Outreach Program except Leadline, the Pleasure Division and the Brass Ring Invitational Medal. Please see the show office for FREE membership into this fun program created by USHJA. This show is not rated by the USEF, and is part of the Regional High Score Program for the PHSA.

### RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Horse Show Committee, the Horse Show organizers, Wyndor Farm or property owners will not be responsible for any damage, injury or loss to persons, horse/pony or property of any exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
2. Classes for juniors will be limited to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to 12/1/2023.
3. ASTM approved helmets must be worn when mounted. No exceptions.
4. The decision of a judge is final.
5. Make checks payable to: **Brass Ring Horse Shows**
6. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes to expedite the schedule. Management reserves the right to change the ring assignments as appropriate to the weather and efficiency of the show. Management also reserves the right to close entries as necessary. Please pre-enter to avoid any disappointment.
7. The show rings will be open on the morning of the show from 7:00 am to 7:45 am, and at appropriate breaks between divisions. Schooling sessions will be supervised by show staff.

### BRASS RING MEDAL

Entry Fee: \$30.00

Open to junior and adult amateur riders. Open scoring will be used, and the class will be run Open Card throughout the day. Class will be split if there are six or more in any one section. Horses 2'6", ponies 2', adults 2'6". Two equitation tests will be built into the first round.

### GRAND HUNTER & RESERVE GRAND HUNTER AWARDS

Special prizes will be given to the highest and second highest scoring horse or pony throughout the day, based on Championship points. Ties to be broken by blue ribbon count, followed by red ribbon count. Further ties to be broken by judge's choice.
