A Note From Rick: January's special feeder sale was light on volume compared to most months, but it is January and feed prices have become a definite concern in this market. Prices were a little softer and this was the case for the calf market as well. Slaughter cows gained a bit of strength this week as they were \$2-\$3 higher. Slaughter cattle were unchanged along with dairy cattle. The hay market was slightly lower as the averages were down \$10-\$15 a ton. Consignments continue to pile up for the Spring Draft Horse sale and all signs point to a big sale. There haven't been any draft horse sales in the last couple months to test the market. There have been several light horse sales recently that have had very strong prices. I'm guessing that the draft horse prices will follow along to a certain extent and be pretty good as well. As I mentioned last week, the anticipation is definitely building for a great sale in March and the way time seems to fly by, it'll be here before we know it! Just a few days remaining to get your horses in the spring catalog so be sure to get those consignments sent in. Hope to see you at TLA!
