From the Pastor

Over the course of my time as a pastor, I have often changed the way I do things. One of the things that has changed over the last several years is my



preaching. Like a lot of preachers in mainline traditions, I was trained in seminary to use the Lectionary. While there are a lot of positives attached to this method, I made the decision a few years ago to start preaching through books of the Bible. The official term for this is expository preaching. I like it because it allows me to deal with everything in a particular book, even if it is something that I would rather ignore. It also allows all of us to spend more time in intentional study of God's Word.

This coming Sunday, we are going to continue our expository journey through the book of I Timothy. We will finish up chapter 1 and look at the last of Paul's admonitions to Timothy about the importance of knowing and understanding certain things about his faith. This week will talk about knowing our mission. Understanding our calling is part of the picture, but once we have gained an understanding of what God has called us to do, we then have to understand how to live out our calling. Hope to see you Sunday.
