

At 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, August 27, we will head to Kernersville to have lunch at Mae's Vintage Kitchen and to tour Korner's Folly. Mae's is located in an historic home in the town of Kernersville. Their menu consists of soups, salads, sandwiches, some entrees, and, of course, delicious desserts! I know you will find something wonderful to enjoy there as you have lunch with your friends.



Korner's Folly, located just down the street from Mae's, is a wonderfully eccentric house built by an equally eccentric interior decorator. Construction was started in 1878 and "finished" in 1880. Korner continued to make changes and reno-

vations until his death in 1924. Ceiling heights range from 5 1/2 feet to 25 feet, and there is a multitude of fireplaces, each more interesting than the last. There is much to see in the 22 rooms of this 3 story home! I'm sorry to say that due to the era in which these homes were built, they **are not** handicap accessible and aren't able to accommodate those with canes, walkers, or wheelchairs.

Sign ups for this trip will begin Monday, July 1, and run through noon on Thursday, July 11. The cost of the trip is \$26 plus the cost of your lunch. The \$26 must be paid when you sign up. The fee covers the cost of your ticket to see Korner's Folly and transportation. Lunch is on your own. To get your spot reserved, come on by the office, sign up, and give Kim your payment.

Chancel Choir News


