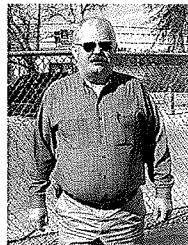

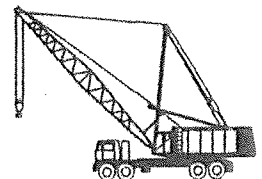

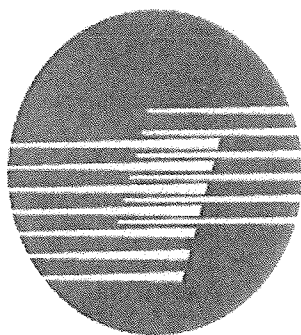
The seminar is open to all SAABE members. RSVP soon, since classes fill up quickly. Our last class was full shortly after we announced it. See about 25 of you there. ❖

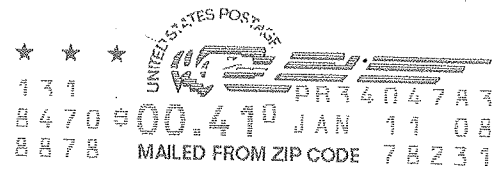
