Grace... Heaven is a free gift

Faith... The gift of eternal life is received by faith.

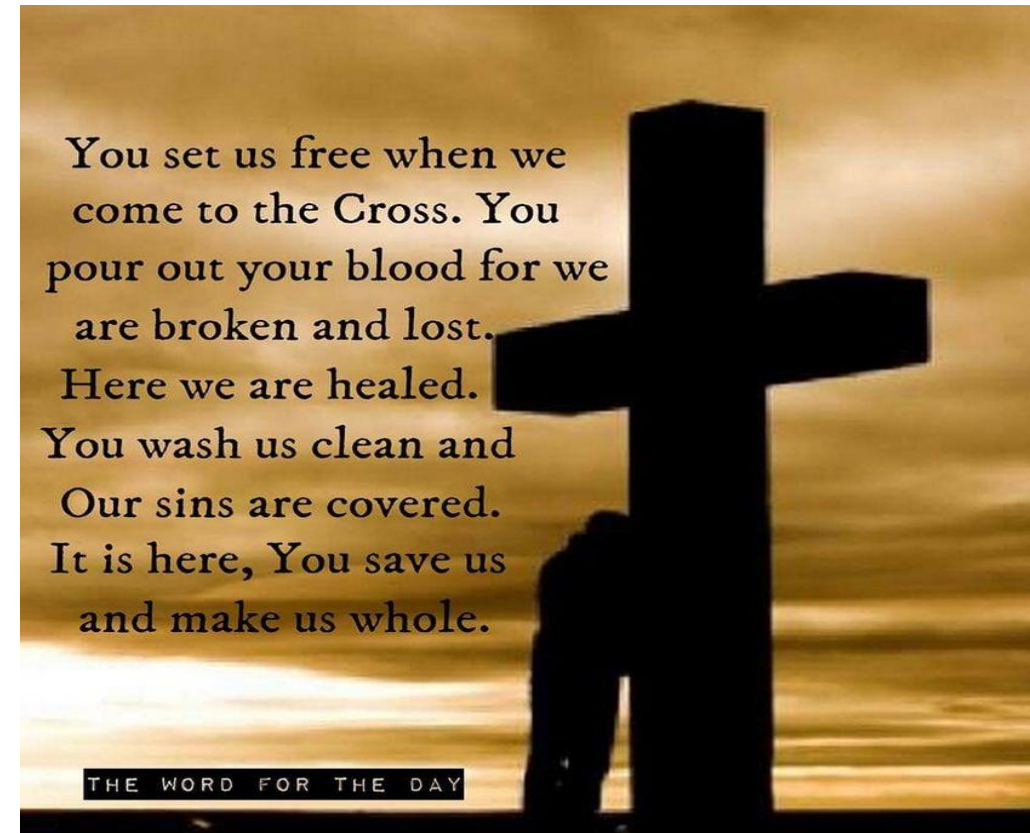

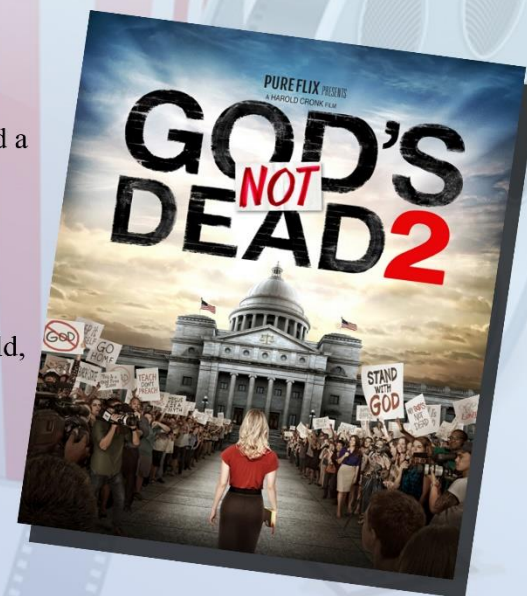
