IDENTIFICATION - DOCUMENTATION

Passport or,
Birth Certificate and Drivers License
PAL Card or Firearms declaration
Airline tickets
Receipts from outfitter
Itinerary
Money – Canadian funds if you have some

GADGETS

Spotting scope and tripod
Binoculars – shoulder straps – hands free carrying
Range finder
Two-way radios
Headlamp
Leatherman

NAVIGATING

Compass – GSP
Bright eyes – reflective thumb tacks
Topo / aerial maps
References from other hunters – hunting strategy / terrain

HARVESTING

Knife
Trail marking tap – blood trailing
Winch system to get game off ground
Drag strap
Tagging carcass – string/ zip- tie
Knowledge of taxidermy- don't' cut the hide wrong
Game cleaning procedures
Butchering knives
Meat cutting supplies
 Wax paper
 Tape
 Marker to label
Utility saw – wood / bone
Quartering – cheese cloth bags
Back pack – frame to carry out meat
Garbage bags

ATTRACTANTS

Calls – moose, buck grunt, doe bleat can, rattling horns
Scent free shampoo
Scent free deodorant
Scents -
Wind dust – check your scent flow often
Scent free clothing and equipment spray
Scent free wipes
Bug spray – dirt smell
Cover scents
Scent wicks

CLOTHING

Boots
 Rubber knee high- insulated
 Rubber knee high – insulated
 Leather – 8" high
 Camp boots
 Pack boots – 1000gram insulated or better
Moisture wicking under garments
Wool socks
Thin socks – double up – prevent blisters
Shower Sandal

Gloves

- Leather – work /camp
- Camouflage – shooting – 2 pair
- Water proof
- Insulated gloves

Raingear

- Camouflage clothing
- Blaze orange – 50% of upper body +hat
- Day pack – shoulder / fanny
- Face mask / paint / dust
- Head net – early season bear, whitetail
- Hand warmers
- Toe warmers
- Carpeted board 2' X 3' to stand on at truck – changing into hunting clothes

HUNTING EQUIPMENT

- Gun / bow - back up gun and bow – guns are somewhat interchangeable 3 guns for two hunters at a minimum.
- Hard case and soft case (soft case for carrying weapon out before dawn and after dusk – it is the law in Canada)
- Shells to fit game
- Guns sling
- Shooting sticks / bi-pod
- Scope covers
- Extra shell clips
- Gun Cleaning kit
- Bow accessories
 - Release
 - String wax
 - Bow tools – allen wrenches, screw driver
 - Arm guard
 - Bow holder – attached to leg
 - Quiver
- Arrows / broadheads
- Practice arrows for at camp
- Target – bow practice – field pt. and broadhead
- Arrow back pack / bow pack
- Trail Camera – digital

STAND/BLINDS

- Tree stands —

- Lock-on
 - Screw in tree pegs
 - Climbing sticks
- Climbing
- Safety straps
- Gun/bow tow line.
- Screw in equipment holder in stand
- Pop up blind – stakes
- Lock – on Seat
- Foam pad

SAFETY

- Waterproof matches
- Safety heat blanket
- High energy bars
- First Aid kit
 - Band-aids
 - Ace Wrap bandages
 - Gaze
 - First Aid Cream
 - Peroxide
 - Pain relievers
 - Cold pack
- Sun Screen – lip and skin
- Whistle

AROUND CAMP

- Duct Tape
- Water proof tarp
- Coolers – 54gal. – great for dry ice transportation
- Chain Saw – tree across road
- Lantern / large lights – trailing game
 - Extra mantles
 - Extra batteries
 - Extra Fuel
- Small tool kit
