Commission Information

The mission of the Salt Lake Diocesan Council of Catholic Women is carried out primarily through the work of four commissions; Leadership, Service, Spirituality, and Legislative.

The <u>Leadership Commission</u> provides organizational development and opportunities for membership training to strengthen leadership. The chairman shall head the committee when bylaws, standing rules, and convention guidelines are due for revision.

The <u>Service Commission</u> engages the members of DCCW, which includes embers of each deanery and affiliate, and all people when possible in working to address the needs and concerns of the individual and wider communities. The Service Commission supports and enhances family life within the Church and society.

The <u>Spirituality Commission</u> reinforces faith and supports service to the Church and to the world through discipleship and spiritual growth. The chair or her designee shall develop and lead a prayer service to open and close each board meeting. The Spirituality Commission shall work with the DCCW President to provide prayer services for the annual DCCW Convention.

The <u>Legislative Commission</u> encourages legislative advocacy at the local, state, and national levels, guided by Catholic Social teaching. The Legislative chair or her designated co-chair and one delegate, appointed by the President, shall attend the Women's State Legislative Council, with required dues paid by DCCW.

Chairs and co-chairs of commissions will be considered members of the Board of Directors. The chair, co-chair, or a representative of each commission shall attend the meetings of the Board of Directors and provide a report of her commission's activities.

In even-numbered years, the Leadership and Legislative Commissions shall help plan the DCCW Convention workshops. In odd numbered years, the Spirituality and Service Commissions shall help plan the workshops.
