### **An Example of Fearless Faith**

#### **Joshua assumes command – Joshua 1-2**

- I. The Messenger - Joshua hears from God
  - A. The Lord’s Message to Joshua (1:1-9) – After the death of Moses, the Lord encourages Joshua in his new role.
    - 1.The Lord establishes the boundaries of the Promised Land (v. 1-6).
    - 2.The Lord states that Israel must read and heed the Book of the Law (v. 7-9)
  - B. Joshua’s Message to the people (1:10-18) –
    - 1.Joshua’s tells the leaders to get ready, for in three days they are going to move out.
    - 2.Joshua reminds and reaffirms to the tribes their promises to assist in conquering Canaan and help for other tribes.
- II. The Mission – Joshua assigns two spies to a special task.
  - A. The spies trip (1:1-22) – They enter Jericho to spy out the city.
    - 1.Rehab’s assistance: The two spies take refuge in the home of a prostitute who has come to fear the Lord.
    - 2.Rehab’s assurance: After asking for safety for her and her family when Israel takes Jericho, the spies agree to spare her and her family.
  - B. The spies testimony (1:22-24) – Upon returning to the camp, the spies reassure Israel that God will indeed deliver Jericho into their hands.
