#### Email & Text Scam

The Diocese of Jefferson city wants to warn the public of what appears to be an ongoing phishing scam involving emails and texts purportedly from priests or parish/Chancery staff. The email or text purports to be from a person the target knows, such as one' pastor, a parish staff member, the bishop or someone else form the Church. Once the target responds to the fake email or text, the sender will follow up with a request for some sort of monetary assistance, often for gift cards or iTune cards. This is not how the priests, parishes or the Diocese of Jefferson City seeks financial assistance for their work. If you receive an email or text from a trusted church personnel asking for assistance, please confirm the request by calling that person. Please do NOT respond to the email or text.
