Effective: Friday March 20, 2020 at 7:00 a.m.

Until: At least through Tuesday April 7, 2020.

Arcade Creek Recreation and Park District Parks remain open for public use during this shelter in place order; for your walk, jog, bike ride or to work on your jump shot!

Please observe social distancing when in the parks. Our society must stop this COVID-19 virus, all of us play important role in this by separating ourselves from others by a minimum distance of six (6) feet, hand washing and stay at home if you do not feel well. Protect your family, your children and grandchildren by making this effort.

Enjoy the parks for 15 to 30 minutes at a time and then move on, social gatherings are not allowed under the shelter in place order. Park District staff are working to keep the parks clean, mowed, and disinfected on a weekly/daily basis. All organized activities, rentals and events have been cancelled and future arrangements are not being made at this time.
