

#24 **VaYikra Parsha Probe**

Rabbi Eukel's **drash** on **VaYikra**

(Leviticus) 1:1—6:6 CJB **You—Heart, Head & Hands—A Living Sacrifice.**

Sacrifice is an invitation to come closer! .

Some have taught "**sacrifice**" is no longer necessary this side of **Messiah Yeshua's** execution stake. They would be wrong.

The key phrase, in Hebrew, is found at **VaYikra** (Leviticus) 1:2. The usual rendering is: "Speak to the children of Isra'el and say to them: when one of you offers a sacrifice to The LORD, the sacrifice must be taken from the cattle, sheep or goats."

The underlined phrase, transliterated, is expected to read: **adam mikem ki yakriv**. It does not. The Hebrew word order is odd. It reads: **adam ki yakriv mikem**. Carefully translated it should read: **when one offers a sacrifice of you**.

Rav Sha'ul (the emissary Paul) understood the odd Hebrew word order. He writes, under inspiration of **Ruach HaKodesh**, about **you and I** as "**Living Sacrifices**" Romans 12:1-3, see also Romans 12:9-13

Today, what **living sacrifice** of **you-heart, head and hands** – do you offer **Messiah Yeshua**?

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Scripture: Leviticus 1:1—6:7 CJB

Sacrifice—Not Over, Still Necessary?

Messiah Yeshua lovingly commands us to *Be & Do a disciplined disciple*: ASK questions. What ANSWERS do you hear? DISCUSS.

- [1] **VaYikra parasha**, Lev 1:3-4, details *Burnt Offerings*, that when accepted brings *Atonement—Sin Forgiven*. Compare 1 John 1:5-10, esp v9. How does “*confession*” reinforce *sacrifices* of **VaYikra**?
- [2] Your rabbi exposes by the Hebrew word order of Lev 1:2 that it should be carefully read as: *when one offers a sacrifice of you* . Do you agree? Why?
- [3] **Prayer** has become the substitute for animal or grain sacrifices, after the destruction of the Temple, A.D. 70. Revelation 21:22 teaches the *New Heaven, Earth and Holy City of Jerusalem coming out of Heaven from GOD* has no *Temple/Sanctuary*. Why will GOD’s Heaven not restore the Temple? See Amos 9:10-11

Discuss (during *Oneg Shabbat*): We are called to be “*Living Sacrifices*” Romans 12:1-3, 9-13. What does that mean and look like in your life on a regular and practical level?

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
