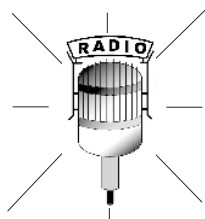

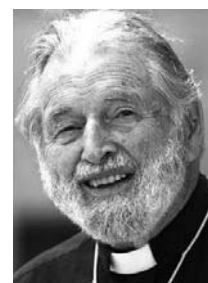

Our Lady has taken care of this Herself, just like she did in Lourdes & Fatima!

I'm sure, by now, many of you have heard the good news, but I wanted to share it in a special way with you today too! On May 31, the feast of the Visitation, Our Lady gave us a wonderful gift! The Vatican press room issued a statement regarding Medjugorje which made us rejoice: Pope Francis has appointed a special Apostolic Visitor for the parish of Medjugorje. To our great joy, this appointee is Archbishop Henryk Hoser, who was appointed with a short term mission in Medjugorje in February 2017. At that time he was asked to acquire a deeper knowledge of the pastoral situation, and to assess the needs of the faithful in Medjugorje.

This mission proved to be very positive; Mgr. Hoser had stated that he was sent by the Pope to "comfort us." "In Medjugorje, there are many spiritual fruits," he said at the end of that mission.

given to Mgr. Hoser, with the renewed hope that this Vatican statement has given us! And most importantly, let us continue to respond to the calls of the Queen of Peace, because it is by living her messages that Medjugorje will bear all the spiritual fruits that Heaven expects. "Make further progress" as said St. Paul to the *Thessalonians* (4.1).

Here is the official text that Fr. Marinko (the parish priest of Medjugorje) read to us that day after the evening Mass. Needless to say it was greeted with much excitement and was widely applauded by the large numbers of faithful who had gathered for the feast of the Visitation and that of the Blessed Sacrament (*Corpus Christi*):

"On this day, the 31st of May, 2018, the Holy See has appointed Henryk Hoser, SAC, the retired Archbishop of Warsaw-Prague (Poland) as Apostolic Visitor with a special role for the parish of Medjugorje for an indefinite time, and ad nutum Sanctae Sedis. At the specific request of the Holy See, his appointment is for pastoral

ministry, a continuation of the mission of the special envoy of the Holy See for the parish of Medjugorje, entrusted to Mgr. Hoser on February 11, 2017, and in which he completed in the previous months."

The purpose of the mission of the Apostolic Visitor is to provide a firm and permanent accompaniment of the parish community in Medjugorje and the faithful who come on pilgrimage here, whose needs require a special attention."

Dearest Mother, we thank you so much for the gift of Mgr. Henryk Hoser! Guide him and lead him in his work, and help him to provide the spiritual nourishment the parish community and pilgrims need. May this step forward from the Vatican draw even more people closer to your Son Jesus.

EVERYONE IS SOOOO EXCITED!!!!!!!

We've all heard negative statements from people who said that Pope Francis doesn't like Medjugorje. Why would anyone even say that?

The news of this letter came just weeks after we were discussing the outcome of the bishops first visit with a friend. Our statement was, "Our Lady will have to take care of it Herself, just as she did in Lourdes and Fatima!"

**A Daily Eucharist Reflection – July 7, 2019
- Life of Christ -**

Why did Our Blessed Lord use bread and wine as the elements of this Memorial? First of all, because no two substances in nature better symbolize unity than bread and wine. As bread is made from a multiplicity of grains of wheat, and wine is made from a multiplicity of grapes, so the many who believe are one in Christ. Second, no two substances in nature have to suffer more to become what they are than bread and wine. Wheat has to pass through the rigors of winter, be ground beneath the Calvary of a mill, and then subjected to purging fire before it can become bread. Grapes in their turn must be subjected to the Gethsemane of a wine press and have their life crushed from them to become wine. Thus do they symbolize the Passion and Sufferings of Christ, and the condition of Salvation, for Our Lord said unless we die to ourselves we cannot live in Him. A third reason is that there are no two substances in nature which have more traditionally nourished man than bread and wine. In bringing these elements to the altar, men are equivalently bringing themselves. When bread and wine are taken or consumed, they are changed into man's body and blood. But when He took bread and wine, He changed them into Himself.

Part 32 CHAPTER THREE

THE PROCLAMATION OF THE GOSPEL

A people of many faces Contd.

117. When properly understood, cultural diversity is not a threat to Church unity. The Holy Spirit, sent by the Father and the Son, transforms our hearts and enables us to enter into the perfect communion of the blessed Trinity, where all things find their unity. He builds up the communion and harmony of the people of God. The same Spirit is that harmony, just as he is the bond of love



between the Father and the Son. It is he who brings forth a rich variety of gifts, while at the same time creating a unity which is never uniformity but a multifaceted and inviting harmony. Evangelization joyfully acknowledges these varied treasures which the Holy Spirit pours out upon the Church. We would not do justice to the logic of the incarnation if we thought of Christianity as monocultural and monotonous. While it is true that some cultures have been closely associated with the preaching of the Gospel and the development of Christian thought, the revealed message is not identified with any of them; its content is transcultural. Hence in the evangelization of new cultures, or cultures which have not received the Christian message, it is not essential to impose a specific cultural form, no matter how beautiful or ancient it may be, together with the Gospel. The message that we proclaim always has a certain cultural dress, but we in the Church can sometimes fall into a needless hallowing of our own culture, and thus show more fanaticism than true evangelizing zeal.

118. The Bishops of Oceania asked that the Church “develop an understanding and a presentation of the truth of Christ working from the traditions and cultures of the region” and invited “all missionaries to work in harmony with indigenous Christians so as

to ensure that the faith and the life of the Church be expressed in legitimate forms appropriate for each culture.” We cannot demand that peoples of every continent, in expressing their Christian faith, imitate modes of expression which European nations developed at a particular moment of their history, because the faith cannot be constricted to the limits of understanding and expression of any one culture. It is an indisputable fact that no single culture can exhaust the mystery of our redemption in Christ.

We are all missionary disciples

119. In all the baptized, from first to last, the sanctifying power of the Spirit is at work, impelling us to evangelization. The people of God is holy thanks to this anointing, which makes it infallible in credendo. This means that it does not err in faith, even though it may not find words to explain that faith. The Spirit guides it in truth and leads it to salvation. As part of his mysterious love for humanity, God furnishes the totality of the faithful with an instinct of faith – *sensus fidei* – which helps them to discern what is truly of God. The presence of the Spirit gives Christians a certain connaturality with divine realities, and a wisdom which enables them to grasp those realities intuitively, even when they lack the wherewithal to give them precise expression.

Saint of Miracles

- Part 10

The Miracle of
Mrs. Nohad
El-Chamy



The following story is taken directly from the testimony of Mrs. Nohad El-Chamy from Jbeil. Nohad,

was a fifty-five year old mother of twelve, who suffered from a left Hemiplegia, affecting her leg, arm, and mouth. (Hemiplegia - paralysis of one side of the body.)

On January 9, 1993 Nohad entered Saint Maritine Hospital in Jbeil. A cardiologist received her and referred her to the Intensive Care Unit. After many consultations, X-rays and medical tests, the doctors deduced that the hemiplegia was due to the obstruction of 80% of the left-brain arteries and 70% of the right ones. “In this case no treatment can cure you. Nevertheless, we still have the possibility to perform a surgery later to replace the obstructed arteries by plastic ones,” reported the doctors. She was advised to go home and return to Hotel Dieu Hospital within three months for new X-rays.

Before being discharged from the hospital, Nohad's eldest son, Saad, went to Annaya to the Monastery of St. Maron and brought to her consecrated oil and soil from the tomb of Saint Sharbel. When her daughter applied them on her body, Nohad felt tingles in her hand and foot. Nohad left the hospital.

Once home, Nohad could not leave her bed. Her husband had to assist her to go to the bathroom, and her children had to give her food and water through a straw. She spent the next three days

like this. While she was sleeping, she saw herself going up the stairs of the hermitage in Annaya and attending the mass in the presence of the monks. During the mass, Saint Sharbel gave her communion.

Between the fourth night at home, Thursday, January 22, 1993 and early Friday morning, Nohad was suffering from a severe headache and pain in right side. She started praying to Our Lady and St. Sharbel, saying, “What have I done? Why have you done this to me? What sin have I committed to deserve all this? I have raised twelve children with lots of suffering, prayers and perseverance. I am not imposing my will on you, but if you are willing, you can heal me, or else take my soul. What ever you decide to do pleases me.”

Nohad's husband and children left her to get some rest. At 11 p.m., she had a dream. “I saw a blinding light filling my room, and two monks approached my bed; one of them placed his hand on my neck and said, “I am here to operate on you.” I turned around but couldn't see his face for a blinding light was coming out of his body and his eyes. I said, Father, why do you want to perform an operation? They didn't say I require one. He replied, “Yes, you do. I am Father Sharbel and I have come to perform it.” I turned to look at the Virgin Mary's statuette near my bed and said, “Virgin Mary, please intercede on my behalf. How are these monks going to perform a surgery and stitch the incision without an anesthetic?” I was staring at the statuette, which took a place between the two monks. At that moment, I felt an awful pain while Saint Sharbel was rubbing my neck. When he finished the surgery, the other monk approached me holding a pillow, helped me to sit up straight, put the pillow behind my neck and gave me the cup of water which was beside me, after removing the straw. He put his hand under my head and told me, “Drink this water.” I said, “Father, I cannot drink without a straw.” He replied, “We have performed the surgery and now you have to drink and walk, too.”

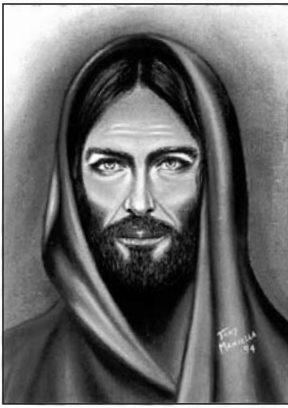
At that moment Nohad awoke and realized that the water was going down her throat normally and she was sitting the way the monk made her sit. The statuette was now back in its original place on the table. She then felt a pain in her neck and unconsciously touched it and realized she was using her disabled arm and could move her leg under the blanket. She got out of bed and knelt before the statuette of Our Lady and the portrait of St. Sharbel to thank them. She went into the bathroom, looked in the mirror, and saw two incisions in her neck; one on the left and one on the right, each approximately twelve cm. It was two o'clock in the morning when she went to her husband's room and explained to him what had happened.

The following day, Nohad, her husband, and their son went to the hermitage to show their gratitude to St. Sharbel. When they returned to their home, all their friends and relatives who visited while she was disabled were surprised to see her recovery. News spread rapidly and visitors came from Lebanon and abroad. After a week, upon the request of the priest of their parish in Halat, and of the doctor, she agreed to stay at her son's home for a couple of days to get some rest. During the night St. Sharbel came to her and said, “Don't leave the people. Keep on your faith. I incised you through divine intervention so that people can see you. A lot of them have strayed from the Church. They are neglecting both to pray and respect the saints. You can't do anything for the people. Those who want anything from me, I am Father Sharbel, and I am always at the hermitage. I want you to visit the hermitage every 22nd of the month and attend the mass for the rest of your life.

The following day she woke up to find three stitches on the right side of her neck and two others on the left side. The doctor later removed them.

My daughter-in-law was diagnosed with ovarian cancer 3 years ago. It's really been rough for her.

About a week ago I picked up the framed print of Louis Saia's Mary painted by Ferdinand titled "Just Trust in My Son Jesus" from Mary's Helpers. It was around 1 p.m. on a Thursday. When I arrived at the home of my daughter-in-law around 2 p.m., she was in bed hurting, trying to sleep and feeling

pretty miserable. I explained what she had to do while the picture was in her house. I hung it on the wall across from her bed. She said, "Well, I guess I'm going to see if I can sleep for a little while, so I left."

About 6 p.m. my son called and said, "Mother, what did you do today?" I said, "What do you mean, what did I do?" He said, "I want you to know she's up, she's not hurting and she's working around the house like a normal person that's not hurting. I just can't get over it!" I said, "Gee, that sounds great, but remember now y'all have to say the Rosary everyday. That's a must."

So she's been having it there and every evening they're sitting there saying the Rosary. This was Thursday. Friday she had a doctor's appointment. They examined her and the doctor told her and my son that he was very pleased. He asked her, "How are you feeling?" "I feel pretty good. I'm not hurting like I use to," she said. "Well that sounds good."

Every day now, she's getting up and doing house work, something she hadn't done for a long, long time; months, years; since she found out she had cancer. She has made a dramatic change. She

seemed angry at the world. Nothing pleased her. She would fight with everybody about everything. Now her disposition is so different, she's so happy. She laughs and talks with people. Before she wouldn't have anything to do with people. Now she gets on the phone and calls her sister and me. We sit and talk for the longest time. Before she was hurting and tired. This morning when I went to visit her she was in bed, because she had become drowsy from medication. Since the picture of the Blessed Mother has been in her home, she has been full of energy. We hadn't seen her that way in quite some time.

Thursday morning, I returned the picture to Mrs. Margaret. Thursday evening, I returned home and my son gave me a call. He said, "Mother, the doctor just called. He gave me the results on Shirley's ZA125. It's been running approximately 70-77 and that's very high. He told him that they just got the results back and it is down to 33. That is where he likes to see it, somewhere below 37. This is the first time my daughter-in-law ever had such good results on that test. He seems to think that the cancer cells are not floating around as they were before. Thank God and the Blessed Mother. *More Next Month*

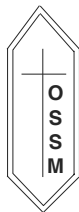
