




Sonoita-Patagonia Time Trial

ONLINE REGISTRATION ONLY

- What?** An 11.7 mile point-to-point time trial with an elevation loss of 700 feet.
- Where?** To reach Sonoita, take Interstate 10 to exit 281. Then follow AZ-83 25 miles to Sonoita. Allow 1 hour travel time from Tucson. Registration and parking is at the Sonoita Fairgrounds. South of the corner of AZ-83 and AZ-82.
- When?** **MAY 12, 2019.** Packet pick-up 7:30 to 8:30am. First rider off at 9:00am.
- How Fast?** Bring your aero equipment. This course is 30+ mph average speed, depending on the wind. Helmets must be CPSC-certified.

- How Much?** **\$30 registration.** Juniors \$5. One day licenses \$10. Buy a **NEW** annual USAC license and ride this race for free.
