- Unfortunately, the Athletic Dept. has advised its Star Football Program has already been completed. Denise J. offered to give the BBF free ads in upcoming journals but this is not the outcome expected. We had hoped to offer additional advertising in that program to anyone taking out an electronic ad through the BBF. Also, a decision still needs to be made on whether we want to use different advertising tiers to sell ads, which would run for 1 year from whatever the start date turns out to be.
- Campus Beautification. Apparently a few years ago we started using Sickles for planting. While meeting with Natale from Sickles this past Monday, Peggy, Valerie and Molly Gearty, who offered to be the go-to person for the planting, started thinking about planting trees by the sides of the front entrance to the school. Because the trees could not be planted before Homecoming, and the price would be about \$2,500, we decided not to go ahead. Will think about that in the Spring or after the addition to the school is completed, since we do not know if construction would cause whatever the BBF has planted to be ripped out.

Also, concern was expressed that what the BBF is having planted is not being maintained by the school's grounds maintenance personnel. The consensus this evening was that maintenance and upkeep of BBF plantings are not something the BBF should be funding. Peggy said the next time she and Valerie meet with Lou Moore, she will bring this up.
