Volunteer Information:

- The work day begins at 8:30am, with a morning break, lunch break, an afternoon break, and ends at 4:00pm.
- Food and drink will be provided.
- Most tools are available on site, but it can be helpful to bring your own. We suggest a tool belt with hammer, tape measure, utility knife and pencils. Remember to label your tools.
- Wear work boots or sneakers that are slip resistant and fully enclose the foot. Open-toe and open-heeled shoes are not allowed on site.
- We work rain or shine.
- Wear a hat and clothes that you won't mind tearing or staining. Work gloves, goggles and hard hats are provided, but you may bring your own.
- A first aid kit will be available on site as well as a telephone for emergency use. Should you need to be reached in case of emergency, the Twin Cities Habitat for Humanity Office can forward any information to the work site (651.207.1700).

Catholic School Parents' Association (CSPA)

For many years St. Cecilia's has maintained a commitment to Catholic education by inviting parents enrolled in area Catholic elementary schools to form an informal association to help develop funds for a grant program to off-set their tuition costs. To be eligible for these modest grants, participating parents sign an agreement to participate in developing a fund-raising event to help build the fund. In addition, our parish also has a special collection during Catholic Schools Week in early February. A grant amount (based on available funds) is sent in early Spring on the parent's behalf to the school where their child attends. Interested parents must sign an enrollment agreement by September 1st of the school year with the commitment to participate in the fundraising process. The grant amount will be determined by the total of funds raised by a distribution date around April 15th of that school year. St. Cecilia's will once again take part in Project Home in August. We are one of five congregations that staff the site at St. Matthew's Episcopal Church in St. Anthony Park. The week we will be staffing this year is Sunday, August 4th through Saturday, August 10th.

Project Home is a program sponsored by Interfaith Action of Greater St. Paul. It is a year-round program that hosts families in need of temporary shelter. Twenty beds are brought to a different hosting site each month, and the families arrive by bus around 5:30pm and stay overnight, leaving at approximately 6:30am the following day. They are able to spend their days at Family Place in downtown St. Paul.

Volunteer Information

We will be asking for 5 volunteers to arrive at St. Matt's, 2136 Carter Ave., at 5:00pm to greet, help with snacks, and play with the kids, staying until 8:30pm. Also needed will be 2 overnight staff, from 8:00pm until 6:30am. The overnight staff sleep in their own space. They are there in case of an emergency, which is rare. **Sign up via the St. C's website Outreach**/ **Project Home tab.** There will be an orientation July 28th because the space has been totally remodeled at St. Matthews.

Please consider this ministry, as a family or individually. It is very well facilitated, and putting a face to the very real problem of homelessness is something that will change you.
