INTRODUCTION




Passes are available for purchase at the City Hall finance office, Public Library, UW-Platteville Student Center Information Desk, and Piggly Wiggly Customer Service Counter. If planning to ride, please stand next to the bus stop. Busses will arrive within six minutes of scheduled arrival.

Description of services: The ADRC operates on two routes, North Route and South Route. Service is provided using wheelchair accessible buses four days a week on each route. Persons 60 and older, disabled of any age, and persons under 60 if there is room available can ride the bus. Riders can use the bus for medical appointments, visiting friends and relatives, shopping, lunch at a senior dining site or at a restaurant of their choice. A minimum fee of \$2.00 or \$3.00 is charged for a round trip on the bus with 50 cents being charged for stops in between.

Descripción de los servicios: El ADRC opera dos rutas, Ruta Norte y Ruta Sur. El servicio se proporciona el uso de sillas de ruedas autobuses accesibles cuatro días a la semana en cada ruta. Las personas mayores de 60 años, discapacitados de cualquier edad, y las personas menores de 60 si hay espacio disponible puede viajar en el autobús. Los pasajeros pueden utilizar el autobús para citas médicas, visitas a amigos y familiares, compras, almuerzo en un sitio de comedor o en restaurantes de su elección. Existe un cargo mínimo de \$2.00 o \$3.00 es cobrado por una ida y vuelta en el autobús y 50 centavos es cargado por cada parada de por medio.
