NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Dogs & Bitches - For dogs and bitches 7 years of age and older.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

Best of Breed (Variety) Competition - The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC."

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class - For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch Class - For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not be the owner of the produce. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merit of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her produce and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

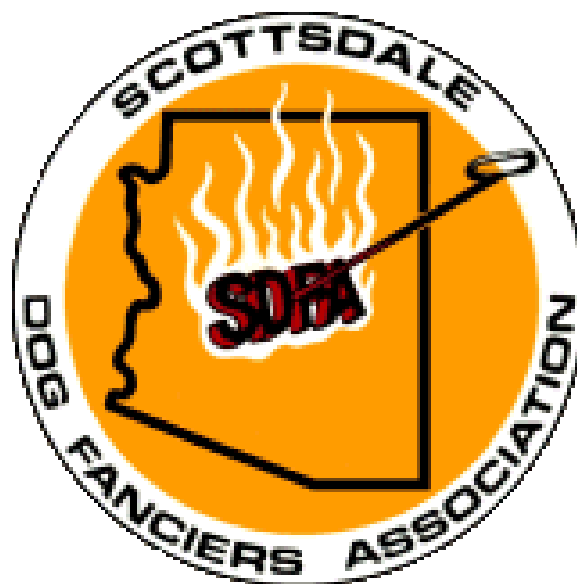

Grand Best Junior in the Fiesta Dog Shows

All Junior Showmanship class winners from the Friday, Saturday and Sunday all breed dog shows are eligible to compete for the Grand Best Junior of the weekend. Class winners are eligible to show throughout the weekend but may opt out of Sunday's regular competition in order to rest for the preliminary finals.

Grand Best Junior will be announced in the group ring prior to group judging on Sunday and the preliminary finals will be comprised of a 3 person judging panel - Top 20 Style. These judges will be announced at the Preliminary Finals ring. On Sunday, regular junior showmanship class judging will be in the morning while finals preliminary judging will take place in the afternoon.

SUNDAY FINALS JUDGING:

STAGE 1 – PRELIMINARY: All Junior Showmanship class winners from the Friday, Saturday and Sunday all breed dog shows will enter the designated preliminary ring in the afternoon on Sunday. Once checked in, the class will be cut into sections to keep the ring manageable. It will not matter who is in each section, as the scores will be competing all participants against one another. There will be three judges in this ring - while one judge is working, the other two will be observing. Each judge will have responsibility for an aspect of presentation - for example, one will perform individual examination, another will move each handler individually etc. Each judge will have a scorecard and will be scoring each handler based on preset objectives. Once judging is complete, the scores will be tallied. All handlers re-enter the ring and the Top 6 Finalists are announced. These juniors will come to the group rings for the presentation of Grand Best Junior.

STAGE 2 - ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNER: The Top 6 Finalists enter the group ring on Sunday. The announcer will explain the process by which the finalists were chosen, and the 3 judges will allow each junior to do a quick showcase of their skills. Grand Best Junior will then be announced.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLER SERIES FRIDAY, SATURDAY AND SUNDAY

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be conducted following Best of Breed judging in each breed ring. All dogs in the BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements in BOB competition. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handler to leave the ring and then the judge will then select the Best Owner-Handled (BOHOB). The dog and its owner will continue to accrue points for any group placements or Bests in Show.

The top-ranked dogs from the AKC National Owner-Handled Series are posted on the AKC National Owner-Handled Series Points Ranking page. Rankings of the dogs competing in the Series are compiled based on the Best of Breed, Group, and Best in Show placements in this specific Series competition (See Point Schedule). The end of year competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be held in conjunction with the AKC/Eukanuba show in December. Dogs that finished ranked in the top ten (plus ties) for their breed during the qualifying period will be invited to compete in the competition. Dogs exhibited by professional handlers on the day of the event are not eligible for this competition. Dogs exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler on the day of the event are not eligible to enter this competition.

Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

SHOW SITE AVAILABILITY – Polo Field Show Grounds opens at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 23, 2016.

UNLOADING – Limited On-Field Unloading: As a convenience to exhibitors, you will be allowed to drive down the fire lane for unloading at the back of the tents (but not in marked Box Van spaces please). Access via outside perimeter Fire Lane. **RESTRICTED TIMES:** Wednesday beginning 1pm. Show days (Thurs-Sun) must be on field before 7:15am and off field by 7:30am. These time restrictions will be strictly enforced. This access is granted by the Scottsdale Fiesta Dog Shows and may be withdrawn or limited at any time. For unloading at other times, use East & West unloading zones defined below:

UNLOADING ZONES - 2 LOCATIONS: EAST & WEST END OF POLO FIELD These zones will have a 15 minute time limit and are available during and after show hours. You may take your dogs and equipment to the ring but you must return and move your vehicle to a designated parking area. You must unload and move your vehicle within the time limit. Exhibitors not abiding by the rules or by a directive of a member of the Scottsdale Fiesta Dog Shows may be subject to a Show Committee Hearing and have their vehicles towed out of the area or ticketed.

DAY OF SHOW PARKING –Parking attendants will direct exhibitors to park in the designated areas on asphalt & gravel parking lots. Exhibitors not abiding by the rules or by a directive of a member of the Scottsdale Fiesta Dog Shows may be subject to a Show Committee Hearing and have their vehicles towed out of the area or ticketed. Any violations of fire lanes will result in the vehicle being towed.

HANDICAPPED PARKING - There will be limited handicapped day of show parking which will be available on a “first come” basis. There is a golf cart shuttle pick up location in the Handicap parking area for transportation to/from Polo Field show grounds.

GENERATORS & MOTORIZED VEHICLES - All power on the grounds will be provided by the Scottsdale Fiesta Dog Shows. **NO OTHER PORTABLE GENERATORS** will be allowed on the grounds. The **ONLY** carts allowed in the vicinity of the rings will be **OFFICIALLY MARKED FOR SCOTTSDALE FIESTA DOG SHOW COMMITTEE USE ONLY**. Private golf carts will be restricted to traffic on the outside perimeter of the Show Boundaries designated as the fire lanes. The only private motorized vehicles allowed in the vicinity of the rings will be motorized wheelchairs and small individual electric scooters. These scooters are available for rental from our on-site cart vendor.

GROOMING & SET-UPS - Grooming tents and set-up areas are designated and supervised by the Scottsdale Fiesta Dog Shows., and/or their designated agents, who will be available to assist and enforce the set-up starting Wednesday, March 23th at 1pm. No portable generators are allowed on the show grounds. No vending may take place under any grooming tent. Guards will be on duty Thursday - Sunday and on the days of the shows, but the Scottsdale Fiesta Dog Shows cannot be responsible for any personal property left unattended on the show grounds.

RESERVED GROOMING - Reserved grooming spaces, with power, will be offered to all exhibitors. This is for the convenience of the exhibitors, to allow those with reservations to arrive at the venue at anytime with the assurance of adequate set-up space. Please see the reserved grooming section of the premium list for details and restrictions. All crates, chairs, and equipment must remain within the limits of the designated space.

PUBLIC GROOMING SPACE - There will be non-reserved, powered space under tents. This will be available on a first come / first served basis. Exhibitors are not permitted to mark-off or reserve space in the public grooming tents. Exercise pens are not permitted under tent in these areas. No portable generators are allowed on the show grounds. No vending may take place under any grooming tent. There will also be some Day of Show crating only areas under shade.

PERSONAL SET-UPS (EZ-ups, canopy tents, etc) – are permitted in designated areas. No set-ups will be permitted within twenty feet of any ring. No crates, exercise pens, grooming tables, or set-ups will be permitted in the aisles. No portable generators are allowed on the show grounds. **The Fiesta Dog Shows are Not Responsible For Loss Or Injury Due To Tenting Not Provided By The Scottsdale Fiesta Dog Shows.**

RINGSIDE SHADE TENTS – RINGSIDE CRATING

The shade tents at ringside are for the convenience of the exhibitors while their breed is being exhibited. It is expected that exhibitors will occupy the shaded area no sooner than fifteen minutes prior to the scheduled exhibition time, nor later than five minutes after completion of their breed judging. Dogs may be left unattended ringside **ONLY** while that breed is in the ring being judged. Owners or agents who violate these regulations, will be subject to disciplinary action as exacted by the Show Committee.

Compliant with WestWorld Sec. 120 Photography Requirements

Our event's venue, **WestWorld** has newly edited Rules and Regulations regarding Event Photography. Effective immediately, the following Show Photography Policy is in effect.

Official Photographer: Like all shows, we have OFFICIAL contracted photographers listed in our Premium List. Only the OFFICIAL photographer is permitted to take "win" photos. NO ONE is permitted to take "win" photos "over the shoulder" of the official photographer or use the designated "win" photography photo stand for photos. A separate "public use" photo stand will be available.

Amateur Photographer: As an amateur photographer you are welcome to photograph this event. You are always welcome to take photographs of your own dog, provided you are not interfering with the official photographer.

Contractual and Spec photographers will check in at the Information Booth on the show site Thursday or Friday morning to receive/provide forms and pay any applicable fees. EXPRESS WRITTEN PERMISSION of the Show Chair, or their designee is required prior to taking any photographs on the show site. At that time the appropriate official identification will be provided before photographing will begin.

Contractual Photographer: If you have been hired to take photographs of dogs, you must notify the Show Chair to this fact.

Spec / Candid / Ring-Side Photographer: If you are shooting unsolicited photographs of dogs that you will later offer for sale through your own website, FaceBook, etc., the same rules apply as above. Photographers who are hired by publications to take photographs are considered to be Spec Photographers. If you were hired directly by a specialty club, the same rules apply as above.

Info: Please refer to the official Scottsdale Fiesta Dog Shows website for appropriate contacts and forms. Whether or not written permission is granted will be based on various criteria, including but not limited to existing agreements with the Official Photographer(s), and the payment of a vendor fee. (All vendors will be listed on our website.) The vendor fee for Contractual and Spec Photographers is \$20 day or \$50 for the weekend.

Photographers not in compliance with this policy will be asked to leave the show grounds. Any photographs taken at our show and offered for sale without permission will be considered the property of the Scottsdale Fiesta Dog Shows.

From North (Flagstaff): I-17 South to SR-101 loop – Eastbound into Scottsdale. Take Pima/Princess exit. Make a left at Bell Road (second light) continue East on Bell Road. Turn right on 94 Street. Travel South to WestWorld Entrance. Follow signs for Dog Show.

From South (Tucson): I-10 to US 60 (Superstition Freeway), US-60 East to SR-101 Loop, SR-101 North to into Scottsdale. Exit at Frank Lloyd Wright Blvd., move to far right lane. Continue straight, crossing Frank Lloyd Wright intersection. WestWorld entrance is ½ block north on the right at large horse statue.

From East (Globe): US 60 (Superstition Freeway) West to SR-101 Loop, SR-101 North to into Scottsdale. Exit at Frank Lloyd Wright Blvd., move to far right lane. Continue straight, crossing Frank Lloyd Wright intersection. WestWorld entrance is ½ block north on the right at large horse statue.

From West (California): I-10 East to SR-101 loop North (near Tolleson). Remain on SR-101 into Scottsdale. Take the Pima/Princess exit. Make a left at Bell Road (second light). Continue East on Bell Road. Turn right onto 94th Street. Travel South to WestWorld Entrance. Follow signs for Dog Show.

Please note that WestWorld has 2 entrances. The main entrance is located just North of Frank Lloyd Wright on the northbound access road of SR-101. The North entrance is at 94th Street and Bell Road.

ADDITIONAL RULES

1. Entries must reach the Superintendent, Jack Bradshaw, 5434 East Olympic Boulevard, Los Angeles CA, 90022, by Noon, Wednesday, March 9, 2016 PT. Fees should accompany entries. This club and/or its superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its superintendents assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and declined credit card. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check or declined credit card MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
3. Exhibitors' Identification tickets and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the superintendent. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held at the Superintendent's Office. PLEASE BRING YOUR IDENTIFICATION TICKETS TO THE SHOW.
4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, In order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring.
5. Trophy cards for prizes will be awarded in the judging rings. In the event of any discrepancy from the published prize list; the superintendent's office should be advised at once. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available at akc.org
7. The club, its superintendents or their employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an owner, exhibitor or handler, spectator. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.
9. Declination of Entries. The Scottsdale Dog Fanciers Association and Arrowhead Kennel Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Clubs or any official thereof.
10. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
11. A Recording Fee of 50 cents and an Event Services Fee of \$3.00 (and a \$3.00 Rally Fee if applicable) will be required at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule, Ch 11, Sec 2.)
12. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.
13. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the Closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the Show, whichever is earlier.
14. These will be "self-cleaning" shows. Cleaning equipment will be provided at various locations. Your help in providing a better show environment is requested and appreciated.
15. Liquor Rules and Regulations: The City of Scottsdale's concessionaire agreement with M Catering dictates that only M Catering may supply alcoholic beverages for events or activities scheduled on WestWorld property. No glass containers are allowed on the property.
16. Exhibitors not abiding by rules may be subject to a show committee hearing and have their vehicles towed out of the area
17. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience or rally title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
18. No practicing allowed in rings at any time.
19. Due to safety concerns, the use of retractable/ flexi-leads on the show grounds is not permitted during show hours. All dogs must be on a lead not to exceed 6' and under control at all times.
20. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations
21. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.
22. Bitches in season are ineligible to compete in trials. To receive a refund, a veterinarian's letter needs to be received by the Superintendent no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for bitch in season cancellations.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitution must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC go online at www.akc.org

Junior Handler's must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank. You may obtain your number by calling the AKC (919) 233-9767.

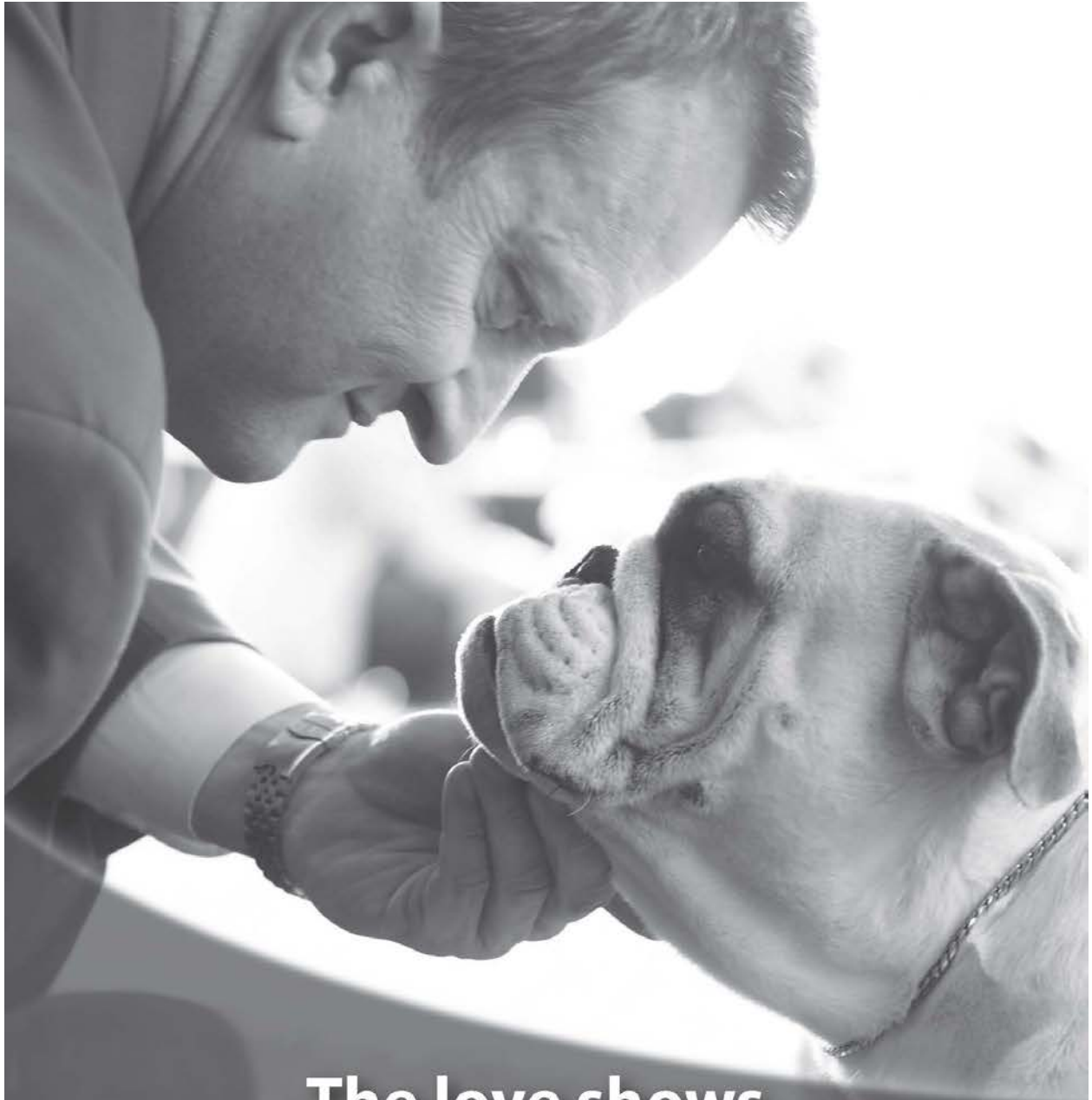
