High School Courses: TCSF hires California credentialed teachers, who are credentialed in the subject they teach at the high school level, and they follow TCUSD curriculum. Credit courses offered for High School students have been deemed acceptable for inclusion on the Temple City High School transcript and will be counted for full credit based on student performance.

THINK CAREFULLY ABOUT SUMMER SCHOOL BEFORE REGISTERING:

- Due to the compressed six-week schedule, High School summer school courses move much faster than courses taken during the regular school year. A typical summer school day is equivalent to one week of school during the regular school year. Be prepared to spend at least one hour on homework for each hour spent in class.
- All High School students are expected to attend the first day of class on Monday, June 17th, 2019. In case of an emergency illness, which would prevent you from attending on the first day, your parent must call the office at (626) 548-5044, before the beginning of your class, or your seat will go to another student from the waiting list.
- Students absent more than 5 hours or 1 day from a 5 credit course, or 10 hours or 2 days from a 10 credit course, for any reason, may be dropped from the class with an “F” grade.
- Vacations and appointments should be made outside of the summer school scheduled dates and class hours.
- If at any time prior to June 17th you decide not to attend summer school, please call the TCHS at (626) 548-5029 so that your seat may be filled with someone from the waiting list.
- Students who are dropped from a class for any reason will not receive a refund. No exceptions.
- Students who drop after the second day may receive an “F” on their transcript.
- All High School students are expected to complete the entire session of summer school whether it is for semester credit or for a year’s credit.

High School Summer School courses allow students to accelerate progress toward graduation and college entrance requirements, improve GPA for eligibility purposes, make-up for deficient graduation credits or ease the stress on student scheduling during the regular school year.

TCSF CANCELLED CLASSES

Unfortunately, classes that do not meet enrollment requirements may be cancelled by TCSF. This process can occur in late May or early June. If TCSF must cancel a class, the parent or the guardian will be notified and have the option to select another available class, or request a refund for the full tuition of the cancelled class. The processing fee is not refundable.

FULL CLASSES & WAITING LISTS

When classes become full they will no longer appear as a choice during the process of Registration.

Each year there are several classes where enrollment is competitive and the course becomes full shortly after registration begins. If facilities and qualified teachers are available, TCSF will open an additional section of that class. Unfortunately, it is not always possible to meet the demand for a particular class when it becomes full. Occasionally a student will cancel their registration, freeing up a spot in that class. You can request to be placed on a waiting list for your desired class by calling TCSF at (626) 548-5029. This is a first come, first served list of requests. You will be notified if a spot becomes available in the class of your choice.

TUITION / REFUNDS & WITHDRAWALS

- The cost for each Course or Class includes a \$50 non-refundable processing fee on or before May 31st.
- June 1st thru June 14th only 50% Tuition Refund
- As of June 17th, Refund Requests are no longer accepted!
- Tuition is not pro-rated or discounted for partial attendance.
- TCSF does not offer scholarships.
- Students dismissed for disciplinary reasons will forfeit tuition.

PAYMENT

Payment in full is expected at the time of Registration.

- All fees must be paid in full prior to the Start Date of Summer School or the student will be dropped from Class.
- Your cancelled check, cash receipt, or credit card statement, along with your "SEASON ACCOUNT STATEMENT" registration confirmation, is your receipt for TCSF Summer School tuition.

TAX ID DISCLAIMER

The Temple City Schools Foundation operates as a private school providing educational opportunities and does not fall under the federal guidelines governing childcare facilities and does not qualify for the childcare credit.

Tuition for TCSF Summer School Program classes is not considered a tax-deductible expense under current IRS guidelines since educational services are provided to the enrolled student. TCSF will not provide its Tax ID # or receipts for income tax purposes.

EDUCATIONAL ACCOMMODATION

504 Plan or Individualized Education Program (IEP)

The TCSF Summer School Program is designed for students in general education and does not have the additional resources and personnel to support students who may need an accommodation during the summer. Sometimes students who have an IEP or 504 Plan during the regular school year enroll in the TCSF Summer Program with the understanding that the Summer Program does not provide accommodations.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Students who are not currently attending a TCUSD school must provide a copy of their immunization record. The immunization record must include Polio, DPT, MMR, Hepatitis B, Tdap, and Varicella immunizations, the date the immunizations were given, and the Physician's name. The immunization record must be in English. The English translations of an immunization records must be by a licensed medical provider. Download a copy of this record as the last step, during the Registration process. A copy of the record can be submitted online during registration.

MEDICAL CONDITIONS

Please indicate on the TCSF Medical Form any medical conditions that your child has, and any medication he/she takes so that we can assist your student in a safe and incident free summer. Fill out the name of the preferred Doctor and phone number, as well as your preferred Medical Center or emergency hospital.
This form must be electronically signed online.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

All students must adhere to school rules. A progressive discipline system will be used to ensure compliance to these rules. Students may be removed from participating in classes if continued behavioral problems disrupt the education of the participating students. Students removed from class will NOT receive a refund in tuition. Any behavior that would result in suspension in the regular school year will result in immediate dismissal in the summer program with NO refund.
