Anson call suggested that the trees and vines should be ordered immediately if we are going to plant this year. He estimated that \$1,500.00 would cover the costs of the plants for Grand County. Director Taylor moved that Anson Call be authorized to order plants up to the dollar value of \$1,500.00 which if the project is funded by the Four Corners Regional Commission will be paid from that funding, if not funded the Conservancy District will stand the expense. Director Rogers seconded. MOTION CARRIED.
