July 1, 2018, 1 Peter 2:4-10 "God's Living Stone and His Chosen People"

Lead: As you come to him, the living Stone rejected by humans but chosen by God and precious to him you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.


Cong: For in Scripture it says: "See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame."

Lead: Now to you who believe, this stone is precious. But to those who do not believe, "The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone," and, "A stone that causes people to stumble and a rock that makes them fall."

Cong: They stumble because they disobey the message—which is also what they were destined for.

Lead: But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

Together: Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.





July 8, 2018, John 3:25-36, "Testifying About Jesus"

Lead: An argument developed between some of John's disciples and a certain Jew over the matter of ceremonial washing. They came to John and said to him, "Rabbi, that man who was with you on the other side of the Jordan—the one you testified about—look, he is baptizing, and everyone is going to him."

Cong: To this John replied, "A person can receive only what is given them from heaven. You yourselves can testify that I said, 'I am not the Messiah but am sent ahead of him.'

Lead: The bride belongs to the bridegroom. The friend who attends the bridegroom waits and listens for him, and is full of joy when he hears the bridegroom's voice. That joy is mine, and it is now complete. He must become greater; I must become less.

Cong: The one who comes from above is above all; the one who is from the earth belongs to the earth, and speaks as one from the earth. The one who comes from heaven is above all.

Lead: He testifies to what he has seen and heard, but no one accepts his testimony. Whoever has accepted it has certified that God is truthful. For the one whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God gives the Spirit without limit.

Together: The Father loves the Son and has placed everything in his hands. Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on them.



July 15, 2018, Psalm 119:33-45 "God's Holy Precepts"

Lead: Teach me, LORD, the way of your decrees, that I may follow it to the end. Give me understanding, so that I may keep your law and obey it with all my heart.

Cong: Direct me in the path of your commands, for there I find delight. Turn my heart toward your statutes and not toward selfish gain.

Lead: Turn my eyes away from worthless things; preserve my life according to your word. Fulfill your promise to your servant, so that you may be feared.

Cong: Take away the disgrace I dread, for your laws are good. How I long for your precepts! In your righteousness preserve my life.

Lead: May your unfailing love come to me, LORD, your salvation, according to your promise; then I can answer anyone who taunts me, for I trust in your word.

Together: Never take your word of truth from my mouth, for I have put my hope in your laws. I will always obey your law, forever and ever. I will walk about in freedom, for I have sought out your precepts.

July 22, 2018, Psalm 86:11-17, "Let God Lead"

Lead: Teach me your way, LORD, that I may rely on your faithfulness; give me an undivided heart, that I may fear your name.

Cong: I will praise you, Lord my God, with all my heart; I will glorify your name forever. For great is your love toward me; you have delivered me from the depths, from the realm of the dead.

Lead: Arrogant foes are attacking me, O God; ruthless people are trying to kill me - they have no regard for you.

Cong: But you, Lord, are a compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness.

Lead: Turn to me and have mercy on me; show your strength in behalf of your servant; save me, because I serve you just as my mother did.

Together: Give me a sign of your goodness, that my enemies may see it and be put to shame, for you, LORD, have helped me and comforted me.



July 29, 2018, Romans 10:4-10, "A Confession of Faith"

Lead: Christ is the culmination of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes.

Cong: Moses writes this about the righteousness that is by the law: "The person who does these things will live by them.

Lead: But the righteousness that is by faith says: "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?" (that is, to bring Christ down) "or 'Who will descend into the deep?" (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).

Cong: But what does it say? "The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the message concerning faith that we proclaim:

Lead: If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

Together: For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.
