something that needs to be preserved," Keeble stated.

Having spent time with Tofte in a weekly meeting of "young blood" local business-owners, Keeble tested the idea of a partnership.

Born of a north shore commercial fishing family, Tofte was exuberant about the chance to stake a claim in carrying on the family tradition. Tofte's great-grandfather came from Norway to what eventually became the fishing village called Tofte, and her father was instrumental in the formation of the North Shore Commercial Fishing Museum in Tofte.

"I felt like I spent my whole childhood surrounded by the north shore's fishing history, it's in my blood and I've always wanted to be part of commercial fishing here," Tofte said.

Collaborating with "the guys downstairs", ie. three local fishermen who dock their newly formed business called North Superior Fishery just below the hill behind the restaurant, Keeble and Tofte say the two businesses are

inextricably linked.

"They do so much hard work out there on the Lake, in cold weather and early morning, and their price per pound of fish never fluctuates, no matter what they catch," Keeble said.

The property for both businesses was purchased by North House Folk School in 2018 in an effort to support local commercial fishing when the previous owners retired.

"The rest of the world talks about organic food, but here we have fresh Lake Superior fish caught by three locals, that's incredible!," Tofte stated.

Lake trout and herring are supplied to the restaurant by North Superior Fishery, with whitefish and smoked fish supplied by two other fisheries on the south shore.

Plans are to eventually keep the restaurant open year-round, with expansion to indoor dining hopefully next year.
