# Mass Cancellation During Inclement Weather The following policies are in effect for Sacred Heart when inclement weather threatens:



- On mornings when there is a school Mass, if there is a
   2 hour delay the Mass will be at 1:30 p.m. IF school is cancelled, the Mass is CANCELLED.
- If school is cancelled on a day when Mass is in the **evening**, please listen to the radio or call the Parish Office to check to see if Mass is cancelled for that evening. Father Chris will make a decision by Noon on those days.
- Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a Level 3 Snow Emergency, the Catholic Churches will cancel Masses. Catholics in that region therefore, are dispensed from their obligation to attend.
- Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio or internet making a spiritual Communion.
