BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE



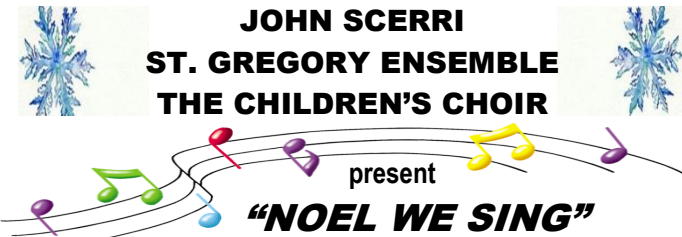
