Job Title: Cook On-call

Status: Non-Exempt

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY:

The Cook On-call is responsible for food preparation, food transportation, assisting the Food Service Manager in maintaining an institutional kitchen in a well-run manner, preparing healthy, nutritious meals while maintaining sanitary conditions. This position classification works on an as-needed basis.

ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES:

- Food preparation for multiple sites and special events.
- Assist the Food Service Manager in menu planning.
- Assist in ordering, tracking and maintaining inventory of all food and food preparation products.
- Maintain sanitation standards.
- Assist in the cleaning and maintenance of the kitchen and equipment.
- Assist in transportation of prepared meals to multiple sites.
- Adhere to established policies and procedures.
- Training and meeting attendance.
- Other duties as assigned.
