January Luncheon Recap

Thank You Jillian Chew with Western Specialty Contractors and Brian Schwab with BASF Watson Bowman Acme for your presentation to SAABE. This presentation focused on concrete repair and restoration. Concrete is the most commonly used building material the world over and we all have it throughout our properties. Walkways, parking structures, walls, you name it, concrete is everywhere. So, it is important for us to help maintain its structural integrity. We need to recognize and address when concrete is becoming compromised. I have heard it said many times, "There is two types of concrete, one that has cracked and one that is going to crack"

Over time, concrete gets distressed and begins to show signs of failure, like, cracking, spalling and flaking. In general, concrete's integrity is most challenged by moisture infiltration. If water gets into cracks, and finds its way into crevices and cracks, it can expand with weather changes, erode the material and cause major points of failure. The biggest culprit for concrete issues in our immediate geographical area of Texas, is extreme thermal cycling.

Here in Texas, as the saying goes, "If you don't like the weather, just wait five minutes." We experience huge thermal swings. It can be rainy and freezing one day, then back to warm dry t-shirt wearing weather the next. When weather temperature changes are extreme from hot to cold and vice versa and happen quickly, the concrete expands and contracts too quickly. When this rapidly changing weather doesn't allow the temperature changes to happen gradually, the concrete becomes overly stressed and promotes failure. San Antonio is roughly 150 miles from the Texas coastline. That may seem far, but it is close enough for strong winds and weather systems to carry some of the salt spray that comes out of the ocean and deposit it onto our buildings and structures. This salt residue will eat at and erode the concrete, destroying it more and more over time. This is why most of the surface concrete distress will be evident on the southeast side of our buildings and structures here in San Antonio.

Be sure to give your building's exterior and parking garages regular visual inspections looking for concrete failure points. If caught and addressed early enough, you can save a good chunk of change in costly repairs.
