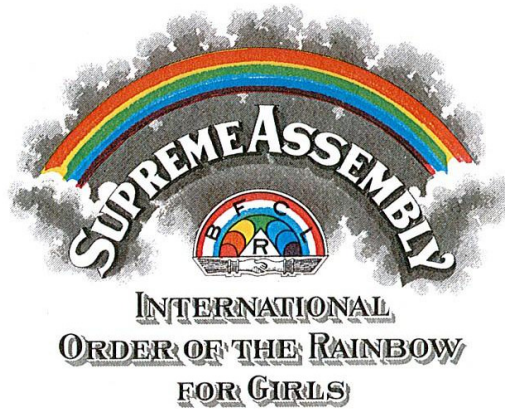

Everyone is encouraged to attend the “A Table Made for a Princess” Banquet on Thursday, the “Let Your Hair Down” Tea Thursday evening, our “Dreams Achieved” awards luncheon on Friday, and our “Moana’s Great Adventure” swim party on Friday evening.

You must be housed with your home Assembly unless you are in the Grand Family. Your own Advisory Board is responsible for chaperoning your activities. Those housed with the Grand Family are under the supervision of their home Assembly. All housing and meal reservations **must be received** by Mother Shirley Kaspari by **May 15, 2019**.

The “Meowington” State Grand Choir will include all Michigan Rainbow Girls. All Rainbow Girls, please bring your white formal and business meeting attire (knee length dress or skirt and blouse) in keeping with the Rainbow dress code and remember to bring your 2019 dues card.

Michigan’s “The Little Kittens” Pledge Group will have their own mini-Grand Assembly and activities. If you have a younger sister, cousin, or neighbor that might enjoy Rainbow Pledges, let your Mother Advisor know.
