### January Sermon Series Restoring the Rainbow Pt 1

#### Genesis - The Life of Noah

January begins a new year, and a new study of the life of Noah! We start at the beginning, before he was born to see that we are just like him - born with a purpose larger than we can imagine. Are you ready for the adventure of a lifetime? If so, be warned...the storms are coming, start building your ark!

#### Jan 1 New Year's Baby Gen 5:28-32

All parents of newborns are excited for the potential that their new baby holds. Noah, on the other hand, was given a very specific future goal that was bigger than he could have wished: to provide hope for the entire Jewish race. Oh, is that all? How do we handle unrealistic expectations of overbearing parents, and more importantly, how do we handle the seemingly unrealistic expectations of our heavenly Father?

### Jan 8 One Ugly Baby Gen 6:2-8

Soooooo...angels have sex with humans, and their babies become heroes...and it makes God mad. Huh? When did the Bible become a prequel for the Game of Thrones? What could we possibly learn from one of the weirdest passages of Scripture? Simple...sin is never something that God tolerates, and wait until you see the plan he sets into motion to solve our problem.

### Jan 15 Baby Safe Gen 6:9-22


