PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Proposed Changes In By-Laws

1. Any team that does not show for more than 2 matches during the season will be assessed ten dollars per no show after 2. Payable with next season dues. No pay no play.
 - a. To change forfeit points from the current 9 to 5.
2. Instead of a 9 point match we propose a 27 point match which is 1 point per game
ex. A team game is won by a 2 of 3 game margin. The team that won the two will receive 2 points, while the team that lost 2 games and won 1 will receive 1 point. If there is no need to play a third game because a team wins the first 2 games, the winning team will receive 3 points.
3. Change in present by-laws to read "2/3 present for voting" rather than "2/3 of membership".
4. Starting date for season start to be permanently fixed to the 3rd week of September.
5. Enforce system adopted by the board 3 years ago: Teams returning with at least 3 of present years' members must move up at least 1 division if they were 1st or 2nd in their previous years' division.
6. Gem Division to add Cricket singles to their matches which could make a 39 point match.
7. Gem Division to be a play league similar to the Tuesday night Pro League. Cost approximately \$2.00 per person per week.

8. A copy of the financial report to be printed in every newsletter.

Responsibilities of officers and board members:

9. PRESIDENT

- a. To preside at all meetings
- b. To be co-signer of DDA checking account
- c. To submit a budget in the newsletter that precedes the first week of play and submit to the board for approval
- d. To be a member and/or tie breaking vote of all committees
- e. To appoint ADO rep
- f. To appoint treasurer
- g. To appoint secretary
- h. To appoint sargent at arms for meetings
- i. To appoint board members to fill resignee seats
- j. To appoint editor for newsletter and approve all expenditures of same
- k. To be final decision in all matters not requiring board approval.
 1. President can be replaced by a 2/3 vote of general membership during his term
 - m. President's term to be for a one year term with consecutive terms unlimited

10. VICE PRESIDENT

- a. To take over all duties of President in case of illness or resignation
- b. To be responsible for points control of league matches
- c. To be auditor of finances
- d. To set up position rounds for league championship and Dayton Dart Open and submit all rules to govern these events

- e. To attend all board meetings and preside when President is not in attendance

11. SECRETARY

- a. To control all correspondence
- b. To notify individuals of board meeting times and dates
- c. To contact proper persons upon cancellation of nights play by President
- d. Any other duties given by President
- e. Attend board meetings
- f. Take minutes at same

12. TREASURER

- a. Maintain DDA records and checking account, make monthly financial report
- b. Co-signer of DDA checking account
- c. Attend board meetings

13. BOARD MEMBERS

- a. Attend all DDA meetings and vote on items brought before the board
- b. Assist the President and Vice President when asked
- c. Serve on committees appointed by the President or Vice President

- 14. League individual fees to be raised to \$15.00 per person in 1985/1986 season.

- 15. Sponsor fees to be \$15.00 per team.

- 16. DDA to maintain no less than a \$100.00 balance with outstanding debts included.

DDA BANQUET

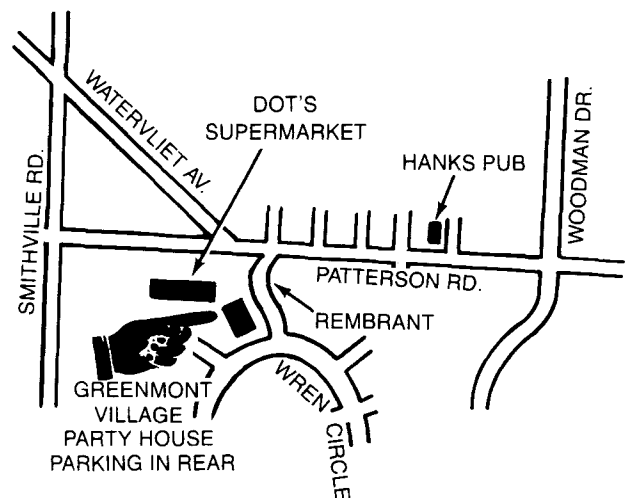
The annual dart throwers ball is on May 19, at Greenmont Village Party House.

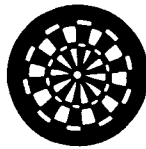

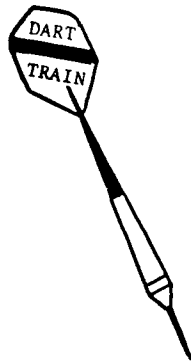


DAYTON CHALLENGED

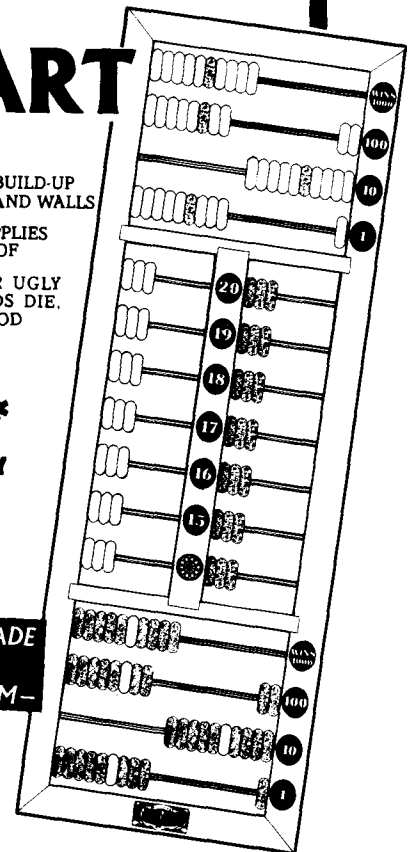

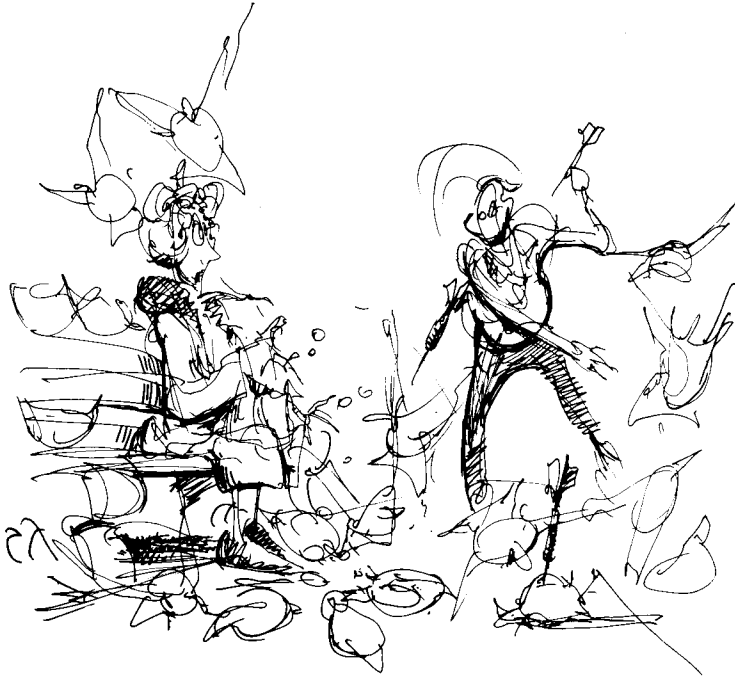
