Covid Update: Effective TUESDAY 6/15/21

STUDENTS:

Per LA County Health Department:

- Youth sports athletes have the **OPTION** to wear a mask while participating in their sport. However, it is no longer required. Optional masks inside the practice area.
- It is highly recommended that the children wear their mask before and after class.
- Non-vaccinated children age 12 and older, who are sitting in the spectator must continue wearing masks.

STARS GYMNASTICS STAFF:

- Employees are subject the Cal-Osha state regulations which will *not* be modified on June 15th. There will be a meeting on June 17th to determine any upcoming changes to policies for business employees.
- At this time, all of Stars Gymnastics staff will continue to wear face masks.

Parents/ Spectators:

Per LA County Health Department:

- Facemasks are required indoors for *Non-Vaccinated* people.
- As of June 15th the state is no longer placing limits on capacity. Stars will be revising our capacity limits to a max of TWO (2) spectators per enrolled student.
- We plan to make additional changes in the near future. However, for the time being & as the masks come off, we still want to be cautious and do what we can to prevent over crowding.

Fully Vaccinated:

- May be protected from getting Covid-19.
- Have protection from getting seriously ill, even if you do get Covid-19.
- Have reduced risk of transmitting Covid-19 to unvaccinated people.
- May remove masks if comfortable doing so.

Un-Vaccinated:

- At risk of contracting Covid-19
- At risk becoming severely ill from Covid-19
- At risk of passing Covid-19 to others
- Required to wear facemasks to protect themselves and others around them.
