I hereby submit the March 2020 Monthly report of activities for the Town of Cohocton Police Department.


1. The department numbers for last month are attached as addendums;

2. During this time of Coronavirus issue. I have issued a Protocol to all officers about how to handle calls and dealing with people that may or may not be effected by the virus. In short most calls will be handled over the phone, if police have to be on scene of a situation, there are masks, gloves and hand sanitizer in both vehicles. Both the Sheriff's Office and New York State Police have initiated similar ways of dealing with the public. Mental Health issues and ambulance calls are top concern, we will maintain as much presence as possible.

3. As mentioned previous there has always been concern from individuals about traffic and speed, I have made an attachment from a previous traffic observation that was done and collected.

4. As the report attachment shows, CPD handled 114 calls for service which resulted in 2 arrest for drug possession, which tested positive for Methamphetamine. 1 AUO arrest, 1 DWI arrest for a total of 47 traffic tickets issued.
