HCC Scoring – What's that?

That – HCC scoring – is important. HCC stands for Hierarchal Condition Coding. CMS created HCC scoring as a means to "adjust risk" by, amongst other things, identifying how sick your patients are. Coding and documenting properly can be very beneficial to your practice – both independently and as part of Silver State ACO. Don't worry if you don't really understand HCC scores or even if you know nothing about them. Silver State ACO to the rescue! SSACO is offering HCC training sessions during the week of September 11th. There is NO cost to you for this training and you can enroll as many people as you'd like – providers, billers, practice managers, etc.. The trainer will come to your office or, if you prefer, there will be two evening sessions, as well – Tuesday, Sept 12th and Wednesday, Sept. 13th –at 6pm (and, yes, we'll even serve dinner). You should have gotten emails about signing up. Even if you missed the emails, please be sure not to miss this fabulous opportunity to learn about HCC scoring, what it means for your practice and why it matters to the ACO. <u>Additional Incentive Payment – from the State of Nevada -</u> for using Electronic Health Records

In partnership with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, the Nevada Division of Health Care Financing and Policy is providing incentive payments to eligible providers as a means to promote the adoption of an approved electronic health records system. The adoption of an electronic health records system can significantly improve performance and patient healthcare delivery, resulting in better patient outcomes. You may receive up to \$63,750 per provider in payments! In order to participate in the program, you must register with CMS **before September 30th, 2017**. What an opportunity! And, if you will be reporting Advancing Care or have filed Meaningful Use in the past, you may already have a lot of the data ready. You must be enrolled in NV Medicaid and use an EHR system. Note that this program is in addition to any filings you may do, and any incentive payments you may earn, with the federal government. REMINDER: There's still time to host Immunization Clinics and Increase your Quality Scores!

In the May newsletter we introduced the immunizations clinics program which has been developed by SSACO in partnership with Smith's Pharmacy. As you know, both influenza & pneumococcal immunizations are CMS Quality Measures. The education and clinical specialist team at SSACO has helped organize an opportunity for you to create an "immunization clinic" - making it easier for the patients to get their shots, including influenza, pneumococcal and shingles.

Smith's Pharmacy has agreed to <u>come to your office</u> at a date and time selected by your practice. Smith's will bring all their own supplies (including the vaccines and sharps containers). They will bill CMS directly, enter the data into Webiz and provide you with a roster of all vaccinations given for you to enter the data into your EMR. You will need to provide an exam room and notify your patients (at their visits, by posting a notice in the waiting room, making phone calls, etc.).

Better for the patients (they get their immunizations) and better for the practice (improved quality scores).
