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Portland Council PTA PTA Hero Award

Directions:

The PTA Hero Award honors an individual in your school or community who consistently steps up when needed. This might be the “behind the scenes” person that helps make things happen. This might be the person who shows up early to help set up and stays late to help clean up. This might be the person who doesn’t always come to meetings or takes charge of an activity but someone that you know you can call on when you are in a bind, in need of an extra pair of hands, short of volunteers, etcetera and they are there for you and your PTA.

Your PTA nomination should include three recommendations from anyone in the school community; parents, teachers, staff, students or community partners.

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Portland Council PTA PTA High 5 Award

Directions:

The High 5 Award is an award open to all STUDENTS in kindergarten-8th grade. The High 5 Award celebrates a student who contributes to making their school a better place. These contributions should align with the PTA's mission and goals by exhibiting qualities such as being helpful, kind and inclusive. ALL students are eligible for nomination.

Your High 5 Award nomination should include two recommendations, from parents, teachers, staff, students plus one recommendation from a member of the community at large such as a coach, clergy person, neighbor, scout/club leader, etc.

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
