
Charles N. S. Norwood CSA Company C, 32nd Tennessee Infantry

Charles N. S. Norwood served in the Civil War on the Confederate side in Company C, 32nd Tennessee Infantry. He enlisted 01 December 1861 at Bridgeport, AL and was captured at Fort Donelson 16 February 1862; was exchanged and sent to Murfreesboro, TN. He died there on 05 November 1862. This can be found on Roll #252 CSA of the Tennessee State Archives. He asked a friend to see that he was brought back to Giles County, Tennessee to be buried which it was. Cause of death is uncertain but most likely due to disease which was not uncommon for soldiers at the time.



The empty chair is a memorial to Charles N.S. Norwood who died during the Civil War. His six surviving brothers in this picture were: William Mitchell Norwood, George Washington Norwood, Edmond Thomas Norwood, James Ambrose Wesley Norwood, and Josiah Harris Norwood.
